Dear Ms. Yates,

Wake County has reviewed plans for the above referenced project, dated January 28, 2026. This review evaluated the proposed impacts to Shelley Lake (Site 13) in accordance with the Wake County Crabtree Creek Watershed Project Policy. It has been determined that the submitted plans show no impact to the Wake County Flood Control Structure or Wake County Watershed/Flood Easement, and no additional review is required at this time.

However, any future plan revisions that may impact the County property or Flood Control Structure must be resubmitted to Wake County for review. Though the plans have been approved, it is our understanding the City still needs to acquire a greenway easement on the County property. City staff should continue to coordinate with Ricky Campbell in Facilities Design and Construction. Wake County's conveyance of the greenway easement to the City

would require Board of Commissioner approval. The Greenway easement must be recorded at the Wake County Register of Deeds prior to commencing any work on County property.
