I. Wake Transit Update

II. Jail Health Plan

NC General Statutes require that jail health plans be developed in consultation with local officials and adopted by the appropriate governing body. The WCSO has been working to update its Detention Center Health Plan. At the April 1, 2024, Public Safety Committee meeting, Commissioners received an update on the progress of updating the health plan. At this meeting, staff from the Wake County Sheriff's Office will present an overview of the required components of the plan and provide updates on the status of required reviews. This briefing is intended to prepare the Board to vote to adopt the plan at an upcoming regular meeting. Commissioners will have the opportunity to ask questions.
