Recognizing September 9, 2025, as First Responders Day

WHEREAS, First Responders in Wake County are prepared to deliver lifesaving services 24 hours a day, seven days a week; and

WHEREAS, These First Responders include Wake County Emergency Medical Services, Fire, Police, NC State Capitol Police, NC Highway Patrol, Wake County Sheriff's Office, and the Raleigh-Wake County Emergency Communications Center (9-1-1 service); and

WHEREAS, First Responders in Wake County significantly enhance the safety, survival, and recovery of individuals facing sudden danger, illness, or injury; and

WHEREAS, The residents, workers, and visitors of Wake County benefit daily from the expertise and skills of these highly trained individuals; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Wake County Board of Commissioners does hereby proclaim September 9, 2025, as **FIRST RESPONDERS' DAY**, and further joins other governing bodies across the County in partnership with the Greater Raleigh Chamber of Commerce.
