- Welcomed over **3 million visitors** across **23 locations**.

- Provided **10,000+ programs** with **300,000 attendees**.

*That's like selling out the Lenovo Center 15 times!*

- Circulated **11.9 million books and materials**.

# In 2024, Wake County Public Libraries:

- Served over 272,000 active cardholders.
- Created over 60,000 library accounts.
- Provided **over 180,000 hours of computer usage.**

*Public PCs were logged on to 225,000 times.*

- Provided over 1 million hours of Wi-Fi connections.
