<u>Item Title:</u> Public Hearing to Consider Renaming a Portion of Mial Plantation Road

Specific Action Requested:

That the Board of Commissioners holds a public hearing and adopts the attached ordinance to rename permanently a 0.4-mile portion of Mial Plantation Road (SR 2509) as Old Country Mial Road, effective April 21, 2025.

Item Summary:

- Purpose: Counties have the authority to rename roads in response to road realignments. State statute requires the Board of Commissioners to hold a public hearing to rename state owned streets outside the corporate limits of municipalities.
- Background: County staff initiated this name change due to NCDOT road realignment at Mial Plantation Road and Major Slade Road. This action renames the short gravel segment of Mial Plantation Road that will be disconnected from the longer paved section.

This road is located in unincorporated Wake County, which requires the county to hold a public hearing before the Board of Commissioners. North Carolina General Statute § 153A-239.1(a).


The proposed name changes affect several buildings at a nature preserve, no residences, and no businesses. If the Board approves this action, the change will go into effect April 21, 2025, and signs will be updated on April 22, 2025.

Staff recommend approving this road name change.

- Strategic Plan: This action aligns with the Board of Commissioners' authority to name roads not within a municipality under North Carolina General Statutes and does not relate to a specific Strategic Plan goal or initiative.
- Fiscal Impact: No additional appropriation is requested for this action.
