FIRST AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT FOR USE OF THE CITY OF DURHAM 2024 HIGH INTENSITY DRUG TRAFFICKING AREA (HIDTA) GRANT BY WAKE COUNTY

This contract amendment is dated and entered into as of the 1st day of September 2025, between the City of Durham ("the City"), a North Carolina municipal corporation, and Wake County Sheriff's Office ("Subrecipient"), a governmental entity organized and existing under the laws of North Carolina.

BACKGROUND. The City and the Sub-recipient entered into a contract titled "Contract for Use of the City of Durham 2024 High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) Grant by Wake County Sheriff's Office," dated August 1, 2024. That contract is referred to as the "Original Contract." The Original Contract is amended as follows:

Sec. 3. Sub-recipient's Billings to City. Compensation. "The City shall pay to the Sub-recipient, an amount up to, but not to exceed \$85,000.00..." is deleted and replaced with the new price of \$119,314.76. The amended portion will now read "The City shall pay to the Sub-recipient, an amount up to, but not to exceed \$119,314.76..."

Except as expressly amended herein, all terms and conditions of the Original Contract shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect. In the event of a conflict or inconsistency among the following documents, the order of precedence will be: (1) this amendment, and (2) the Original Contract.
