

**ORDINANCE APPROVING THE REQUEST TO
RENAME A PORTION OF JAMES SLAUGHTER ROAD (SR 1399)**

WHEREAS, due to development in the area, James Slaughter Road (SR1399) is proposed for realignment approximately 475 feet to the west at the intersection with Bass Lake Rd, to align with Westminster Lane at a signalized intersection; and

WHEREAS, the remaining 0.14 mile section of James Slaughter Road (SR1399) is proposed to be closed to through traffic; and

WHEREAS, to enhance public safety response and maintain an orderly street network, the Town Council of the Town of Fuquay-Varina has determined that the 0.14 section of James Slaughter Road (1399) should be renamed; and

WHEREAS, this 0.14 section of James Slaughter Road lies within the incorporated ETJ of the Town of Fuquay-Varina and Wake County is the entity with the authority to rename roads located in the unincorporated areas; and

WHEREAS, the remaining 0.14 mile section of existing James Slaughter Road (SR 1399) will change to Spainhour Lane; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Fuquay-Varina Board of Commissioners passed a resolution supporting the name changes at their September 17, 2024 meeting; and

WHEREAS, the General Statutes of the State of North Carolina (G.S. 153A-239.1) delegates authority to name and rename roads to the Wake County Board of Commissioners and prescribe procedures to be followed in the process; and

WHEREAS, this request was duly advertised and was the subject of a public hearing by the Wake County Board of Commissioners on October 21, 2024 and was duly considered; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE WAKE COUNTY
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WAKE, NORTH
CAROLINA, AS FOLLOWS:**

That the portion of James Slaughter Road (SR 1399) located within Town of Fuquay-Varina extraterritorial jurisdiction from its terminus at Bass Lake Road running southeast approximately 0.14 miles to the proposed realignment point be renamed Spainhour Lane, effective October 21, 2024.

Commissioner _____ made a motion that the above ordinance be adopted. Commissioner _____ seconded that motion, and upon vote, the motion carried this 21st day of October 2024.
