

**ORDINANCE APPROVING THE REQUEST TO
RENAME A PORTION OF LIGON MILL ROAD (SR 2044)**

WHEREAS, the intersection Ligon Mill Road (SR 2044) and US 401 was realigned by the North Carolina Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the realignment resulted in a disconnected portion of Ligon Mill Rd: and

WHEREAS, to enhance public safety response and maintain an orderly street network, Wake County has determined that renaming the separated portion of Ligon Mill Road will resolve the duplicating road names created by the realignment; and

WHEREAS, Ligon Mill Road lies within the unincorporated limits of Wake County and Wake County is the entity with the authority to rename the sections of road located within its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the General Statutes of the State of North Carolina (G.S. 153A-239.1) delegates authority to name and rename roads to the Wake County Board of Commissioners and prescribe procedures to be followed in the process; and

WHEREAS, this request was duly advertised and was the subject of a public hearing by the Wake County Board of Commissioners on June 15, 2026, and was duly considered; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE WAKE COUNTY
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WAKE, NORTH
CAROLINA, AS FOLLOWS:**

That the portion of Ligon Mill Road (SR 2044) beginning with its realignment point to the south end, extending approximately 0.4 miles, shall be renamed Old Ligon Mill Road. Effective July 15, 2026.

Commissioner _____ made a motion that the above ordinance be adopted. Commissioner _____ seconded that motion, and upon vote, the motion carried this 15th day of June 2026.
