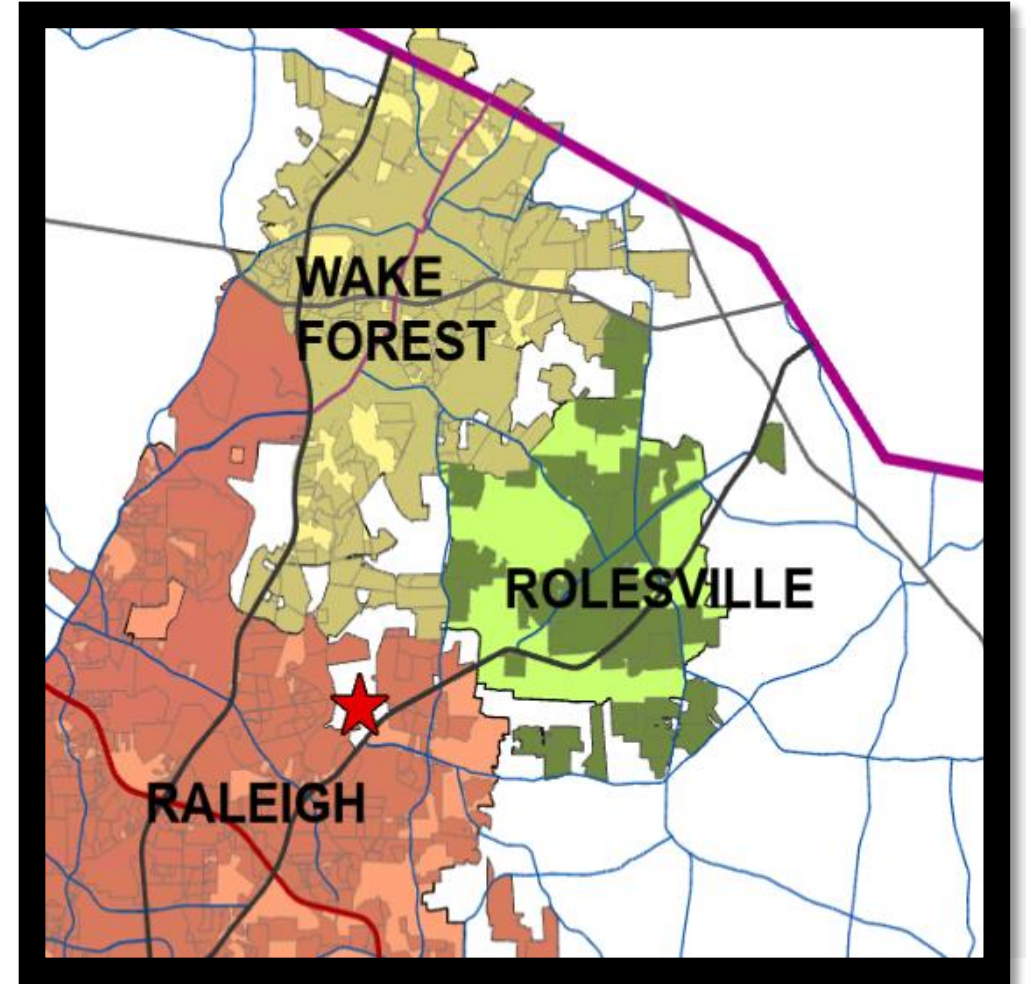

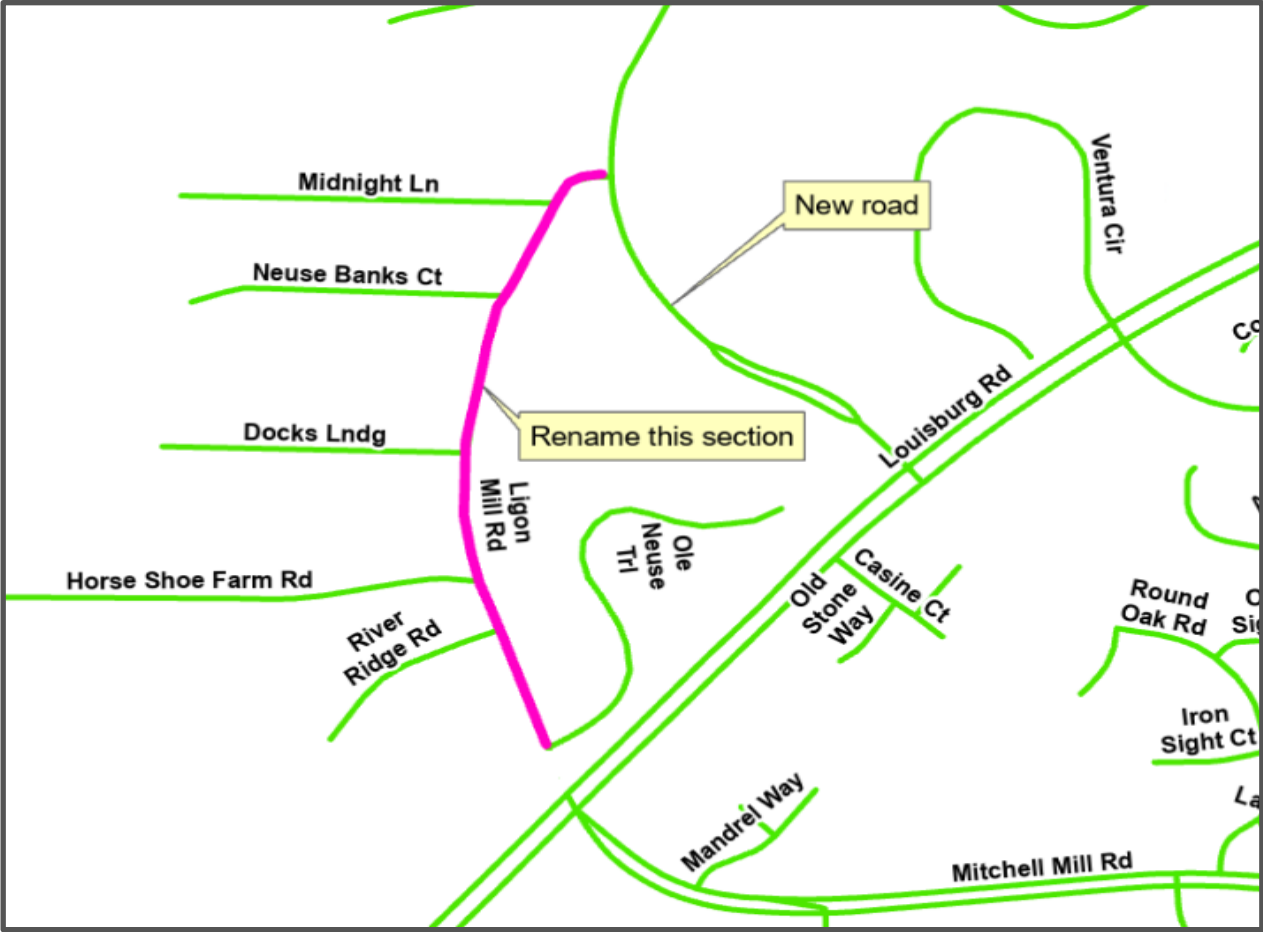

Background

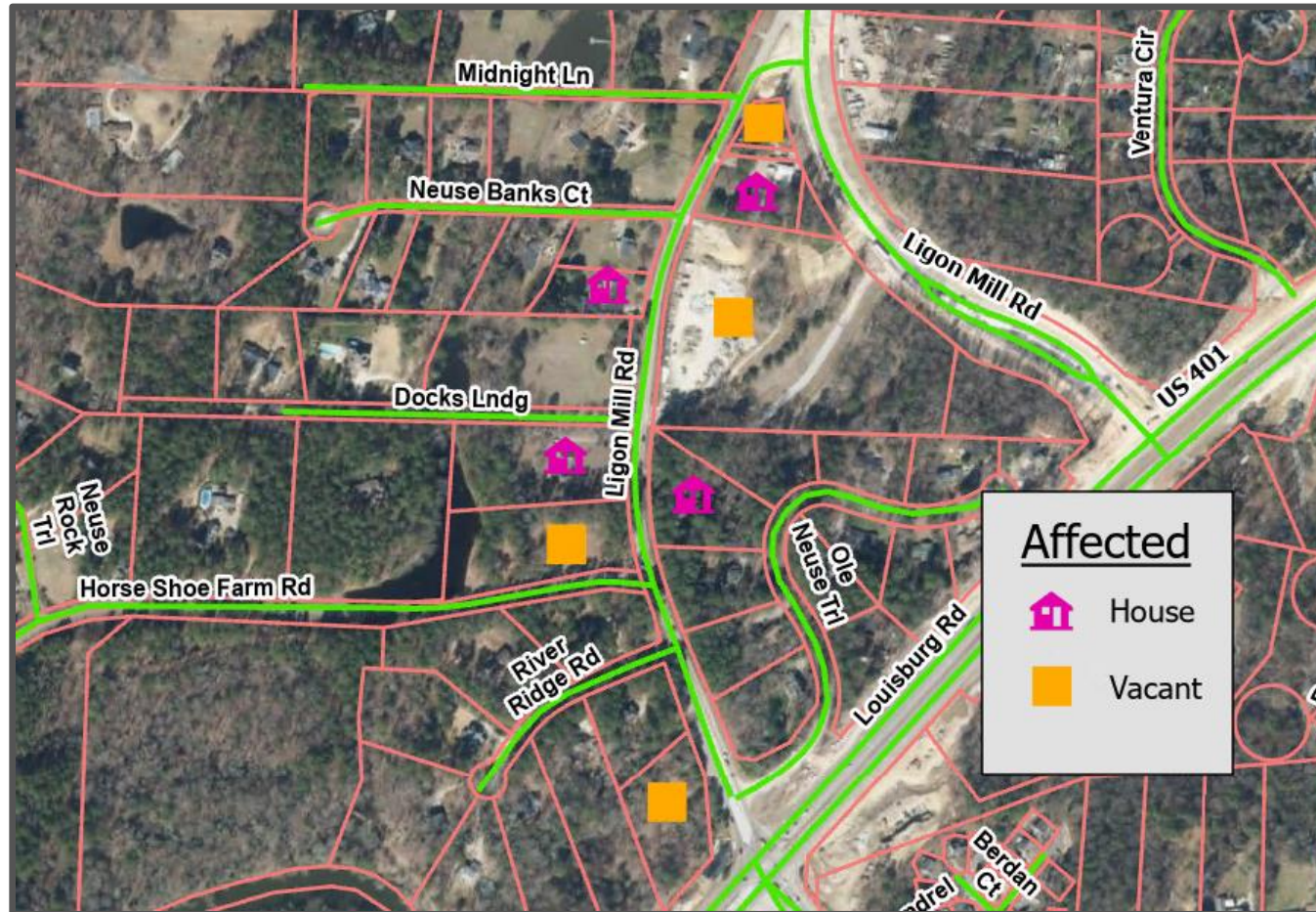
- NCDOT initiated project to improve the street network and navigation

Impact of Name Change



Public Involvement

NC General Statutes

- Requires that the Wake County Board of Commissioners holds a public hearing when renaming roads that are dedicated to the public and not within a city

Public Involvement

NCGS Requirements / Compliance

- Notice of Public Hearing advertised in local newspaper
- Public Hearing notices posted in two locations
- Public Hearing notice posted in the Wake County Courthouse

Impact

- Addresses affected: four residences, one vacant parcel, two NCDOT owned parcels, and one City of Raleigh parcel
- No business addresses affected
- The county will replace seven street signs

That the Board of Commissioners adopts the ordinance approving the name change to be effective July 15, 2026.
