

**ORDINANCE APPROVING THE REQUEST TO
RENAME A PORTION OF MIAL PLANTATION ROAD (SR 2509) AS OLD
COUNTRY MIAL ROAD**

WHEREAS, the intersection of Mial Plantation Road (SR 2509) and Major Slade Road (SR 2506) was realigned by North Carolina Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the realignment resulted in a disconnected section of Mial Plantation Road; and

WHEREAS, to enhance public safety response and maintain an orderly street network, Wake County has determined that renaming the separated portion of Mial Plantation Road will resolve the duplicating road names created by the realignment; and

WHEREAS, Mial Plantation Road lies within the unincorporated limits of Wake County and Wake County is the entity with the authority to rename the sections of road located within its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the General Statutes of the State of North Carolina (G.S. 153A-239.1) delegates authority to name and rename roads to the Wake County Board of Commissioners and prescribe procedures to be followed in the process; and

WHEREAS, this request was duly advertised and was the subject of a public hearing by the Wake County Board of Commissioners on April 21, 2025 and was duly considered; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE WAKE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WAKE, NORTH CAROLINA, AS FOLLOWS:

That the portion of Mial Plantation Road (SR 2509) beginning with its intersection at South Smithfield Road and extending west approximately 0.4 miles to its terminus, shall be renamed Old Country Mial Road. Effective April 21, 2025.

Commissioner _____ made a motion that the above ordinance be adopted. Commissioner _____ seconded that motion, and upon vote, the motion carried this 21st day of April 2025.
