FY26 Recommended Budget Overview

FY2026 Recommended Budget \$2,165,424,000

Makes critical investments to address:

Public safety • State mandates • Impacts of growth

Education • Homeless services • Parks and libraries

Proposed tax increases

Only for the:

- Voter-approved public library bond
- Fire Tax District

Will use natural revenue growth to cover all other budget increases



FY2026 Financial Picture 5

Property tax increase for library bond

Requires a 0.25-cent tax increase, which would:

- Generate \$7.7 million in new revenue
- Set our tax rate at 51.6 cents

The owner of a \$450,000 home would see a property tax increase of less than \$12 annually.

\$142 million bond



5 new libraries

Renovate 9
WCPL buildings

FY2026 Financial Picture



Recommend increasing the fire tax by 1.5 cents to 12.25 cents per \$100 of property value

- Applies only to households in the unincorporated areas and the Town of Wendell
- Owner of a \$450,000 home would pay an additional \$67.50
- Will fund station replacements, salary increases and cost increases due to inflation

FY 2026 Budget Process

- County Manager presented Recommended Budget to Board of Commissioners on May 5
- Capital Work Session with Board on May 12
- Public Hearings on Budget on May 19, May 20
- Budget Work Session today May 22
- Board Budget adoption at Regular Meeting on June 2
