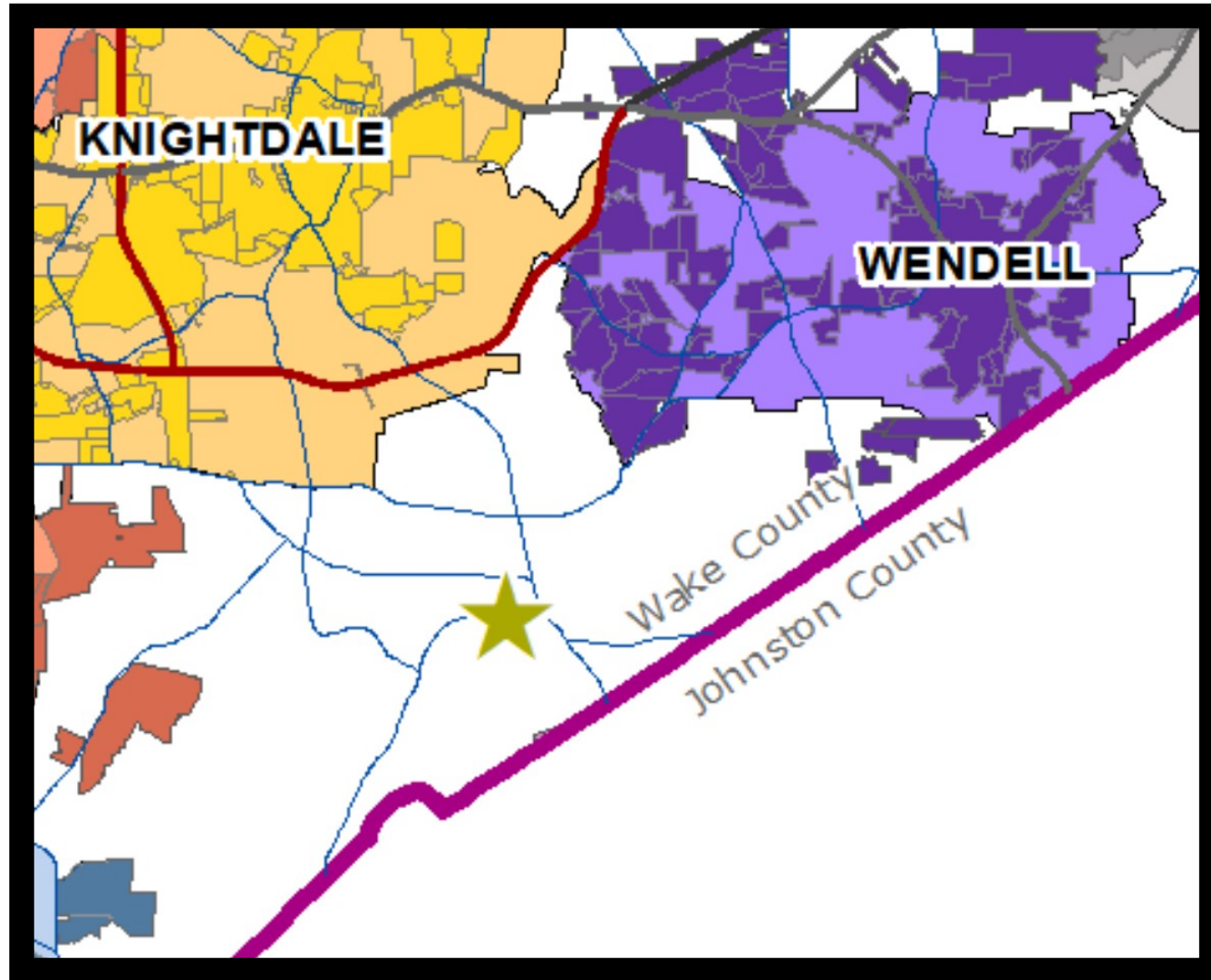

Background



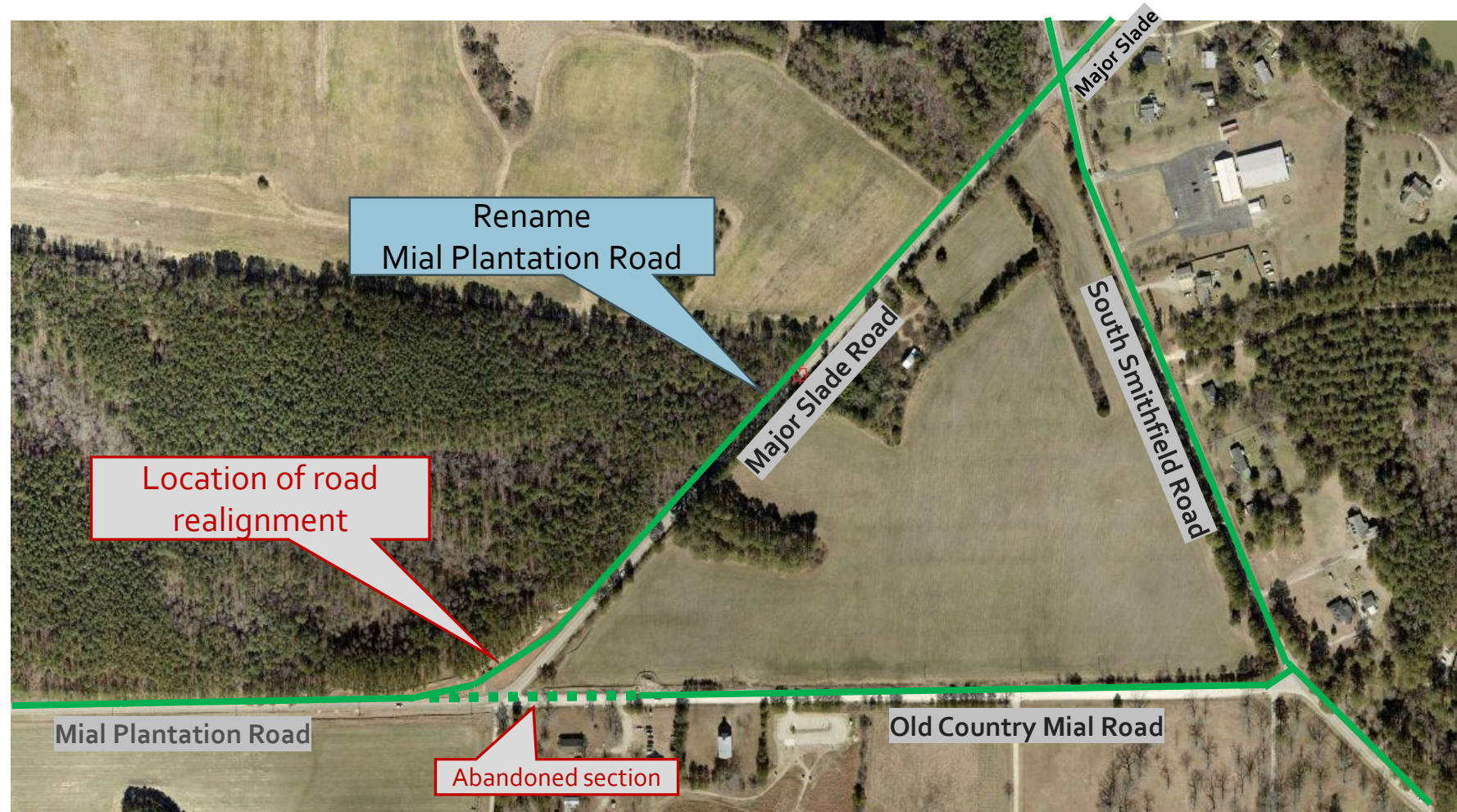
Mial Plantation Road

New road construction

Remove intersection
and straighten curve

New traffic flow from
Mial Plantation Road
onto Major Slade Rd

Creates road name
change at arbitrary point



Mial Plantation Road

County initiated renaming

- Wake County Unified Development Ordinance (8-32-10 – Road Name and Addresses)
 - “Roads that extend or continue existing roads must be given the same name as the existing road, unless otherwise approved by the Planning Director.”
- Established guidelines for maintaining logic and consistency support public safety emergency response



Public Involvement

NC General Statutes

- Requires that the Wake County Board of Commissioners holds a public hearing when renaming roads that are dedicated to the public and not within a city

Public Involvement

NCGS Requirements / Compliance

- Notice of Public Hearing advertised in local newspaper
- Public Hearing notices posted in two locations along road
- Public Hearing notice posted in the Wake County Courthouse

Impact

- 0 address changes to residences
- 0 business address affected
- Wake County GSA replaces one street sign
