I am writing to share information on the [Wake County Water Partnership](#) (WCWP) and request representation from the Town of Zebulon on the WCWP Committee. The WCWP was established by the Wake County Board of Commissioners (BOC) in 2016 and provides expertise and guidance on water-related issues in our community. The committee includes representatives from municipalities, well owners, water providers, agriculture, academics, environmental groups and the building industry and acts in an advisory capacity to identify water related opportunities and challenges that impact the County.

The WCWP has been instrumental in advancing the Wake One Water Plan, a 50-year water plan to ensure that Wake County has the water it needs to support future growth, while maintaining a high quality of life. Key focus areas of the One Water Plan include: Optimizing Water Supply, Strategies to improve Water Quality and Hydrology, Land Conservation, and Flood Resilience. As a rapidly growing town in eastern Wake County, it is critical that we have your voice at the table as we work together to implement Plan recommendations.

The Wake County BOC appoints members to the WCWP. Zebulon may submit an application by clicking this [link](#). The WCWP meets bimonthly on the second Friday of the month from 1-3pm. We are currently alternating between virtual meetings via Teams and in-person meetings that generally include an onsite tour of an area of interest. We will be holding our annual retreat on Friday, February 13, 2026 from 8:30am-1:00pm at Beech Bluff County Park in Fuquay Varina and would love to have Zebulon represented at this meeting.
