## ORDINANCE APPROVING THE REQUEST TO RENAME A PORTION OF MAJOR SLADE ROAD (SR 2506)

**WHEREAS**, the intersection of Mial Plantation Road (SR 2509) and Major Slade Road (SR 2506) was realigned by the North Carolina Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the realignment resulted in the abandonment of this intersection, connecting Mial Plantation Road to Major Slade Road and forming a continuous single segment of roadway; and

**WHEREAS**, one, continuous road name would help minimize confusion for motorists and public safety response personnel, thereby avoiding potential delays in providing emergency services; and

WHEREAS, Major Slade Road lies within the unincorporated limits of Wake County and Wake County is the entity with the authority to rename the sections of road located within its jurisdiction; and

**WHEREAS,** the General Statutes of the State of North Carolina (G.S. 153A-239.1) delegates authority to name and rename roads to the Wake County Board of Commissioners and prescribe procedures to be followed in the process; and

**WHEREAS**, this request was duly advertised and was the subject of a public hearing by the Wake County Board of Commissioners on April 21, 2025 and was duly considered; and

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE WAKE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WAKE, NORTH CAROLINA, AS FOLLOWS:

That the portion of Major Slade Road (SR 2506) beginning with its intersection at South Smithfield Road and extending west approximately 0.4 miles, shall be renamed Mial Plantation Road.

Effective April 21, 2025.
