Main Points

This resolution requests the following appropriation, reallocations, and plan of record change approval:

An appropriation of \$2,114,507.52 to the Continuous CIP Capital Building Program for Fuquay-Varina Elementary renovation project using Public-School Building Repair and Renovation Lottery Funds. This appropriation will partially fund the construction of a new 22,877-square-foot classroom building, which is an approved use of the Public School Building Repair and Renovation Lottery Fund. Construction of the new classroom building is scheduled to be completed in August 2026.

A reallocation of \$2,114,507.52 from Fuquay-Varina Elementary renovation project to Life Cycle Building Components. The appropriation of Public School Building Repair and Renovation Lottery Fund listed above to Fuquay-Varina Elementary allows the return of previously allocated Life Cycle Building Component funds, which will fund priority school buildings life cycle projects.

A reallocation of \$10,000,000.00 from Land/Property Acquisition to Security to partially fund the districtwide safety and security improvements project.

A reallocation of \$6,770,449.94 from multiple completed Continuous CIP projects (completed projects listed in the resolution attachment) to Parkside Middle/ Wake Early College for Information and Biotechnologies to fund projected new school construction costs.

A reallocation and change plan of record of \$0.97 from Garner High to Parkside Middle/ Wake Early College for Information and Biotechnologies to fund projected new school construction costs. Parkside
