

Item Title: Federal Fiscal Year 2022 Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG)

Specific Action Requested:

That the Board of Commissioners accepts and appropriates \$18,406.77 from the 2022 Federal Fiscal Year EMPG program via North Carolina Emergency Management for the purpose of providing a system of emergency preparedness from all hazards in the local jurisdiction.

Item Summary:

Purpose: The Board of Commissioners must appropriate all revenues and expenditures, including mid-year supplemental grants. The grant's intent and use will be to enhance Emergency Management's response capabilities. Specifically, this grant will be used to improve Wake County's WebEOC information sharing platform.

Background: Annually, the State of North Carolina passes through funding from FEMA based on completion of certain activities performed by counties. The State's allocation is awarded to counties based on the number of activities completed statewide.

Board Goal: This action supports routine County operations.

Fiscal Impact: The EMPG requires a 50% match from County dollars. The County will satisfy the match requirement by using funds already budgeted in FY2024 from Emergency Management's operating budget.

Additional Information:

The period of performance for this grant is October 1, 2021 to September 20, 2024.
