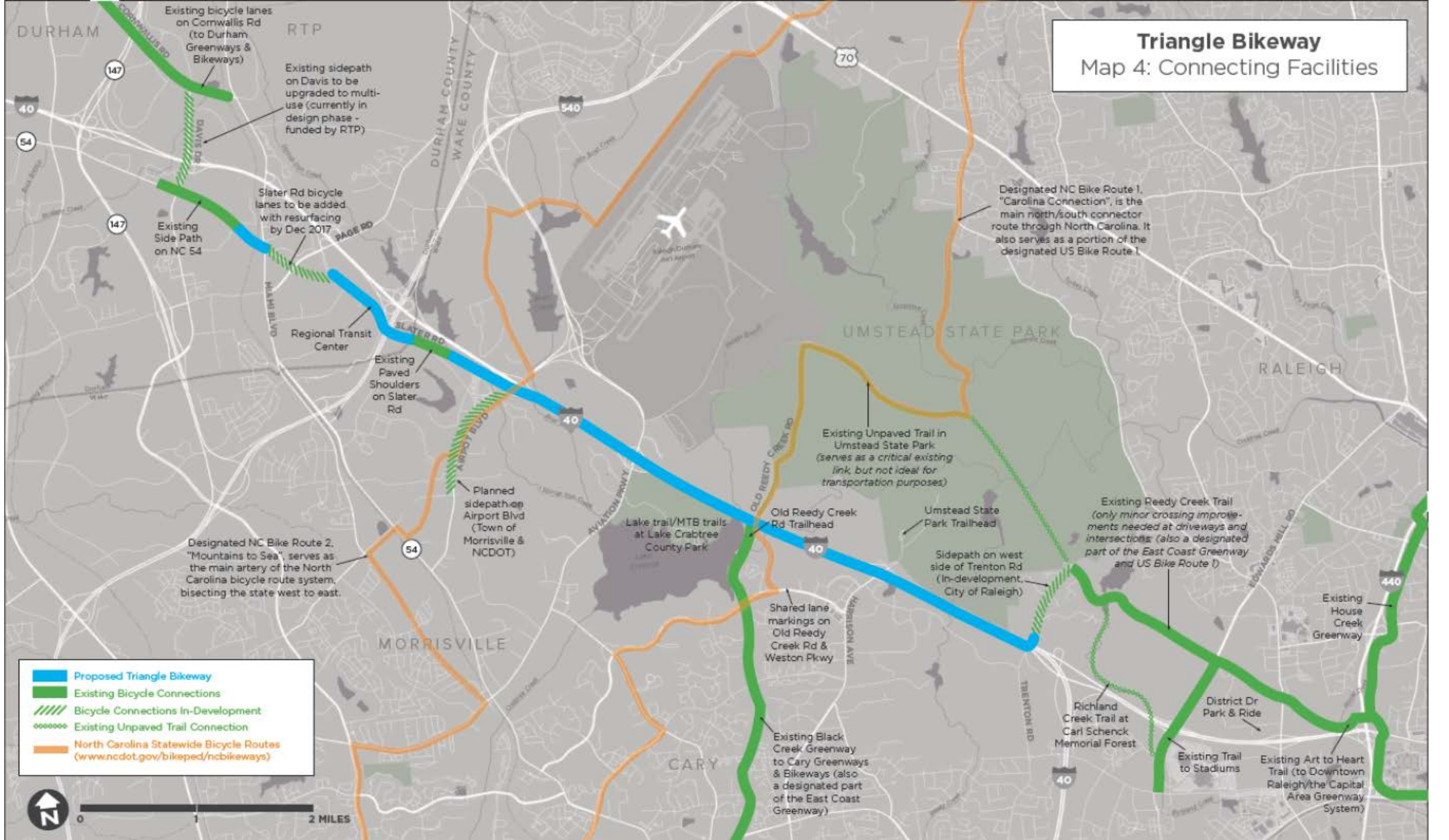


Triangle Bikeway

Designated NC Bike Route 2, "Mountains to Sea", serves as the main artery of the North Carolina bicycle route system, bisecting the state west to east.

Slater Rd bicycle lanes to be added with resurfacing by Dec 2017

Existing bicycle lanes on Cornwallis Rd (to Durham Greenways & Bikeways)

Existing sidepath on Davis to be upgraded to multi-use (currently in design phase - funded by RTP)

Regional Transit Center

Existing Paved Shoulders on Slater Rd

Planned sidepath on Airport Blvd (Town of Morrisville & NCDOT)

Lake trail/MTB trails at Lake Crabtree County Park

Old Reedy Creek Rd Trailhead

Shared lane markings on Old Reedy Creek Rd & Weston Pkwy

Existing Black Creek Greenway to Cary Greenways & Bikeways (also a designated part of the East Coast Greenway)

Existing Unpaved Trail in Umstead State Park (serves as a critical existing link, but not ideal for transportation purposes)

Umstead State Park Trailhead

Sidepath on west side of Trenton Rd (In-development, City of Raleigh)

Richland Creek Trail at Carl Schenck Memorial Forest

District Dr Park & Ride

Existing Trail to Stadiums

Existing Art to Heart Trail (to Downtown Raleigh/the Capital Area Greenway System)

Designated NC Bike Route 1, "Carolina Connection", is the main north/south connector route through North Carolina. It also serves as a portion of the designated US Bike Route 1.

Existing Reedy Creek Trail (only minor crossing improvements needed at driveways and intersections; (also a designated part of the East Coast Greenway and US Bike Route 1)
