Every year, the Board of Commissioners must weigh the cost of pursuing policy goals and maintaining operations against the availability of new revenues. Wake County will continue to face annual questions around school funding, employee compensation, expanding services, and maintaining a capital improvement program. Staff have developed a long-term financial model to help staff and commissioners consider budgetary and tax decisions on a multi-year framework. In this work session, staff will share the model, review major assumptions, and share the forecast. Commissioners will receive the information and ask questions.
