Thank you for your submittal and encroachment request to Wake County dated February 7, 2025. Wake County has reviewed the roadway improvement plans for the referenced project, dated February 6, 2025 and No Net Loss Certification, dated January 17, 2025. This review evaluated the proposed impacts to Brier Creek Reservoir (Site 20A), based upon the Wake County Crabtree Creek Watershed Project Policy. The proposed project does not encroach into the Wake County Flood Control Easement, nor impact the flood storage volume of the reservoir. The project and proposed easement appear to have no negative affect on the functioning of the flood control structure. The roadway improvement project and submittal meets the requirements of the Wake County Crabtree Creek Watershed Project Policy.

The proposed permanent slope easement on County property shown on the roadway plans will require Board of Commissioner approval. Please continue to coordinate with Facilities Design and Construction Real Estate staff in finalizing the easement conveyance.
