On-Scene Command, Coordination, & Communications

- A self-contained, deployable facility for incident command and multi-agency coordination
- Bridges on-scene operations with dispatch and the EOC
- Supports every public safety discipline: law enforcement, fire, EMS, and emergency management
- Designed for both emergency response and large-scale planned events



Two Decades of Continuous Service



- Placed in service 2006 – acquired through Department of Homeland Security grant funding
- Maintained by Wake County Emergency Management
- Ongoing operations sustained through the Wake County Public Safety Radio System Fund
- Housed at Cary Fire Department & Deployed by Station 1 crews 24/7

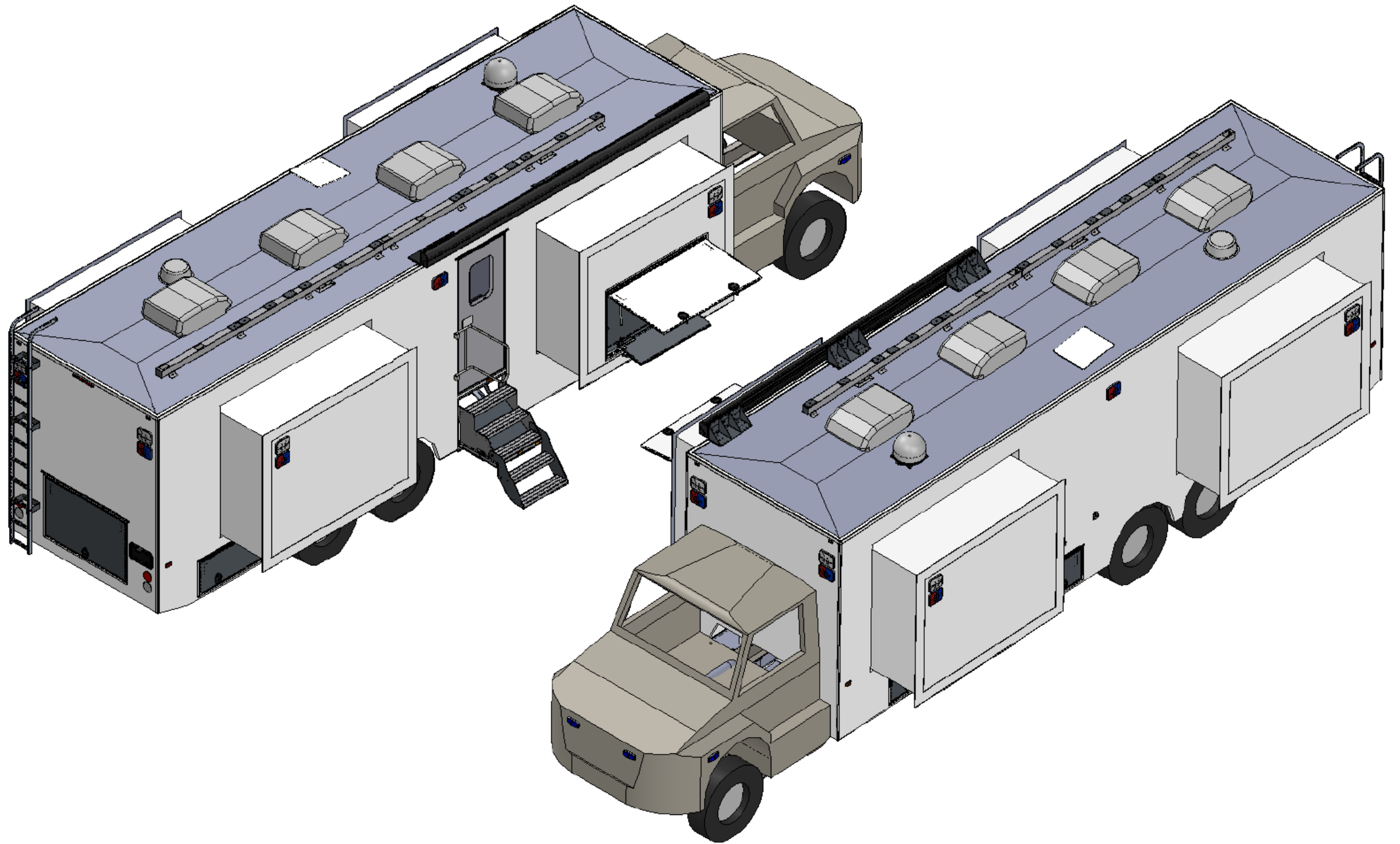

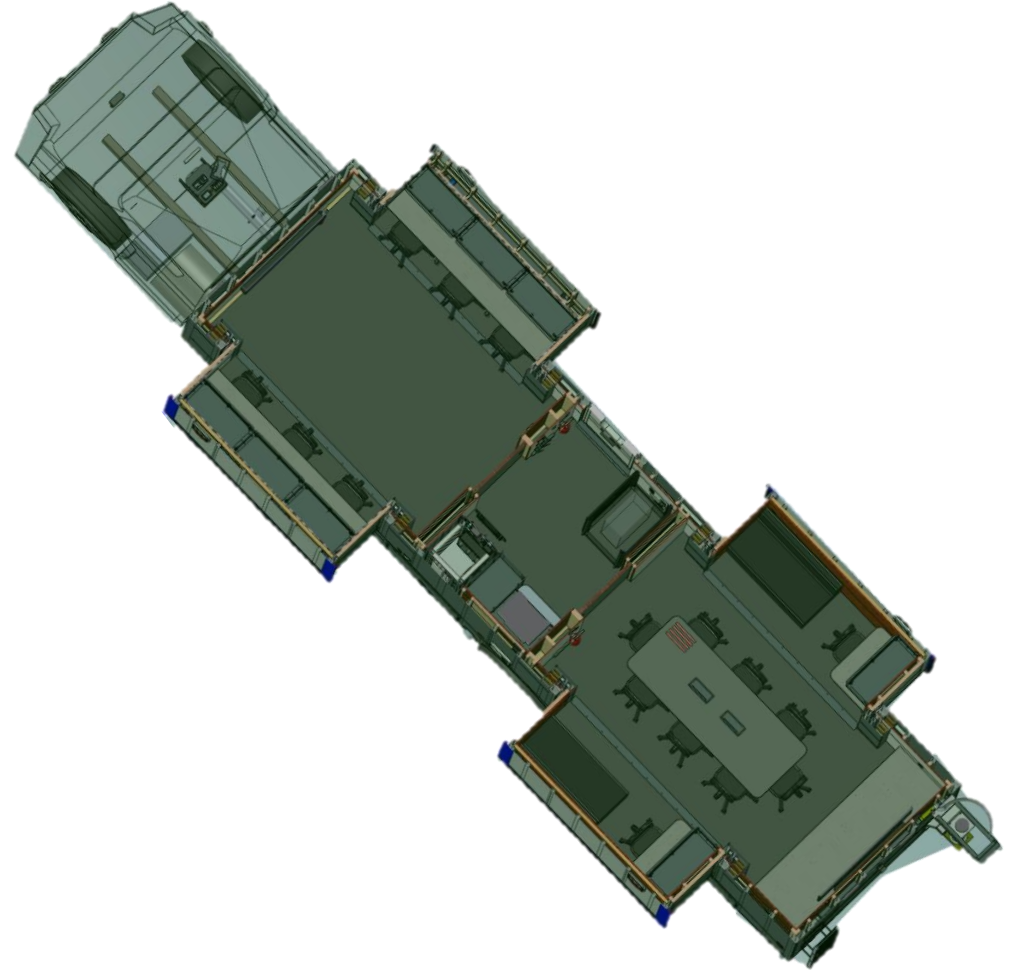
New Mobile Command Post

- **45 feet in length – 5 feet longer than COMM1**
- **Dual slide-outs on both sides for significantly greater interior workspace**
- **Modern integrated communications and technology systems**
- **More workstations – greater capacity for multi-agency personnel simultaneously**
- **Dedicated conference and briefing space for unified command**
- **Funded primarily through ARPA grant funds**
- **Same proven deployment model: Cary Fire Department, Station 1**
- **Estimated delivery: Late August 2026**

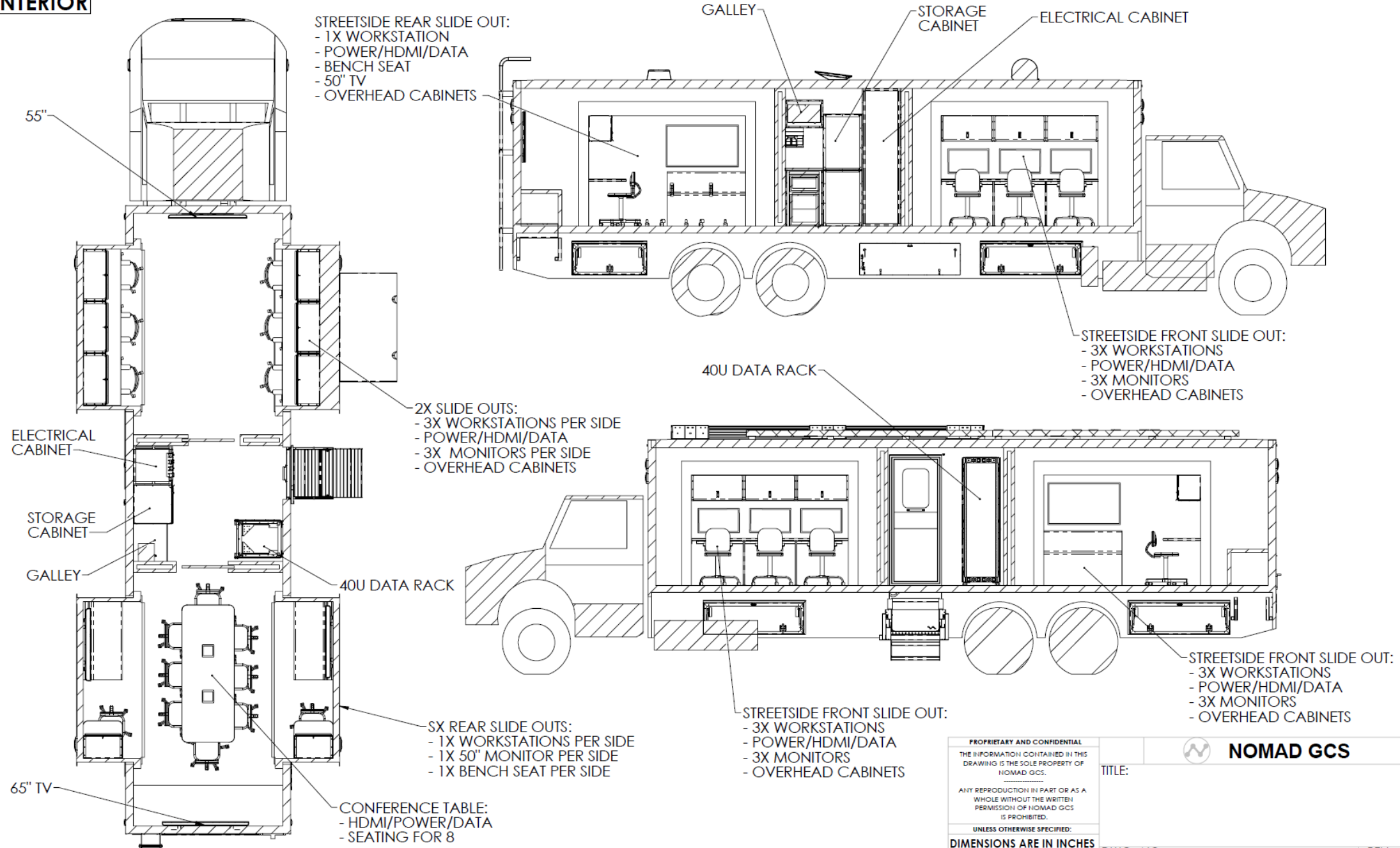


Built for Modern Multi-Agency Incident Command

- Expanded communications workstations
- Additional positions for incident management personnel from multiple agencies
- Dedicated conferencing and briefing area; supporting Unified Command
- Integrated technology for real-time situational awareness
- Improved workspace for extended operations
