<u>Item Title:</u> Technical Correction to Wake County Public School System FY 2026

Capital Improvement Program Reallocations Resolution

Specific Action Requested:

That the Board of Commissioners adopts a technical correction to the October 20, 2025 Resolution to Appropriate and Reallocate Funds in the WCPSS Capital Improvement Program.

Item Summary:

Purpose: The Board of Commissioners is statutorily responsible to fund the

school system's capital projects and approves all appropriations and

reallocations of funds.

Background: On August 19, 2025, the Board of Education passed a resolution

requesting funding for their FY 2026-2032 Capital Improvement Program from the Board of Commissioners. On June 2, 2025, the Board of Commissioners adopted the FY 2026 Budget, which included a total of \$412,776,000 in planned funding for WCPSS capital projects in FY 2026. The Board of Commissioners previously appropriated \$57,500,00 in funded projects and planned the appropriation of debt funding in an amount up to \$355,276,000 in the FY 2026 Capital Improvement Projects Funds Ordinance. On October 20, 2025 the Board of Commissioners approved a resolution

reallocating roughly \$18.5 million.

This item corrects the project totals and Continuous CIP Summary table for Morrisville High, Athens Drive High, Fuller Elementary, and

Life Cycle Equipment.

Strategic Plan: This action supports Lifelong Learning Goal 4: By 2029, three out of

four residents asked will share that Wake County has high-quality education-based facilities, including schools, libraries, and other

educational resources.

Fiscal Impact: This resolution reallocates funds from the WCPSS 2006 CIP, 2013

CIP, and Continuous CIPs to provide additional funding for Morrisville High School, Athens Drive High School, and

Lifecycle/Playground Equipment.
