Whenever me and my neighbors walked around trails in Cary, we would ask each other questions like, 'I wonder who decides to put the crosswalk here,' or 'Why is this stream suddenly flagged for cleanup?' I realized there was a gap between the work the County does and the people who feel its impact. That's the role I want to play: a translator and a bridge. I'm interested in serving on a Board or Commission because I want to play a more active role in supporting and strengthening Wake County, especially when it comes to awareness about the local government, which not a lot of people seem to know about nor participate in. My time on the Health Board at UNC Charlotte taught me how to do that—how to take a student's frustration about clinic hours and turn it into a policy proposal that actually worked.
