

## WAKE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS PROCLAMATION Recognizing October 2019 as Breast Cancer Awareness Month

WHEREAS, a woman receives a diagnosis of breast cancer every two minutes, making this disease the most frequently diagnosed cancer among women in the US other than skin cancers; and

WHEREAS, through research and advocacy, significant advances have been made in the fight against breast cancer, including five-year relative survival rates for localized breast cancer of 99 percent; and

WHEREAS, throughout the month of October, women are encouraged to make a renewed commitment to following recommended screening guidelines and to make a mammography appointment; and

**WHEREAS**, throughout the month of October, health practitioners, organizations, and public officials are encouraged to promote breast health awareness and refer women to appropriate resources for mammography screenings; and

**WHEREAS**, the Wake County community is encouraged to participate with educational activities and programs that support breast health practices; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Wake County Commissioners, on behalf all the residents of Wake County, does hereby proclaim the month of October 2019 as Breast Cancer Awareness Month.
