### 3. Adoption Awareness Month Proclamation

Ms. Kimberly Herrington, Wake County Human Services Supervisor, said that adoption provides birth parents the assurance that their child will be raised in a stable family, adoptive parents the joy of parenting, and children and youth the ability to grow up in a stable and loving home. Children and youth that experience the care through adoption have a better outcome than those in foster care. She said Wake County Human Services has completed 108 adoptions of children and youth in Fiscal Year 2018 and has completed 42 since July 2018. She said that in Fiscal Years 2017 and 2018 an average of 14 adoptions for youth ages 18 and over were completed by Wake County Human Services.

She asked the community partners and Human Services staff that were present to stand and be recognized. She recognized an adoptive family that was present.

Commissioner West recognized Ms. Regina Petteway, Wake County Human Services Director. He said the Proclamation indicates that the future of adoptive children are in good hands.

He read the Proclamation aloud.

Chair Holmes said there are over 600 children in Wake County's care and 65 children available for adoption. She asked Ms. Petteway to share the phone number for citizens interested in adoption.

Ms. Petteway said if citizens are interested in adoption she can be reached at 919-212-7759.

Commissioner West moved, seconded by Commissioner Burns, that the Wake County Board of Commissioners receive a brief presentation from Wake County Child Welfare and proclaims the month of November as Adoption Awareness Month. The motion passed unanimously.

Chair Holmes recognized Commissioner Portman and Commissioner Burns for their work and leadership toward moving forward with the Resolution supporting the resettlement of refugees to Wake County.

Commissioner Portman said that history is filled with those that look for a beacon of hope. He said the country has pulled together for those that feared for the safety of their families.

Commissioner Portman read aloud the Resolution.

Commissioner Burns said that he has worked in the past with the legislature to receive refugees that come into Wake County seeking a better life for their families. He said that it is the hope that the citizens will embrace the efforts of the board.

Mr. Scott Phillips, Director, US Committee for Refugees and Immigrants, said the Resolution is a good first step for local government to stand by a commitment for local value.

Commissioner Portman moved, seconded by Vice-Chair Hutchinson, that the Board of Commissioners adopt a resolution reaffirming support for the resettlement of refugees to Wake County. The motion passed unanimously.

Ms. Betty Parker, Senior Director, Real Estate Services, Wake County Public School System, commended the board for recognizing adoption. She said that Social Services provided her the opportunity for siblings through adoption.

Ms. Parker said that she is presenting information about a land acquisition for a land bank school site in Western Wake County (Cary/Morrisville/research Triangle Park Area).

Ms. Parker shared maps of the growth trends of the actual density by planning units of residence from 2002, 2012, and 2022. She shared maps of the Western Wake/Cary/Morrisville/RTP area schools' target ring area. She shared maps of the middle and high school target areas for the 2018 update of the seven year plan. She shared charts of the middle school and high school utilization in Western Wake.

Mr. Parker shared a target ring map of the limited options based on the development that has already occurred, airport and related overlay, the county boundary, and Research Triangle Park restrictive covenants. She shared a land bank site GIS aerial photo and a proximity map to Wake Tech RTP Campus. She shared maps of the preliminary feasibility study for the land bank for the Middle School and 9-10 High School Program. Ms Parker shared the contract terms and information.

- Seller: Research Triangle Foundation of North Carolina, a North Carolina non-profit corporation. Land was acquired in 1965 when the Research Triangle Park was created and its expansive holdings assembled.
- Land To Be Purchased: A 44.141 acre parcel located on the southern side of Little Drive west of its intersection with Davis Drive, and adjacent to Parkside ES in RTP.
- Purpose: Land bank site to accommodate a future school(s)
- Negotiated Purchase Price: \$7,724,675 Dollars (±44.0 acres @ \$175,000 per acre).
- **Due Diligence Period:** 180 days from contract execution.
- Appraised Value: MAI appraisal was procured and supports the purchase price.
- **Utilities:** Water and sewer services are available at or near the site.

She shared a chart of the land acquisition comparison. She shared the atypical contract terms and information.

- Seller provides survey at its cost.
- Restrictive Covenants Amendment: Current recorded CC&R
  preclude use of the property as a public school. Seller obtained
  approval from the Owners' and Tenants'
  Association during due diligence for an appropriate amendment to
  allow school use.
- RTF Right to Repurchase: Seller retains the right to repurchase the Property

- If Board does not start construction of a public school within 10 years
- If Board elects to sell the Property prior to construction start of a public school on the site
- Naming Consideration: Board agreed to Include "Research
   Triangle Park (RTP) \_\_\_\_\_ School(s)" in its
   naming considerations (Same as E-50 contract terms)
- RTP-Compatible Focus. Board/WCPSS agreed to explore
  opportunities to develop an academic theme, focus or concentration
  for the future school(s) that is compatible with the research, technical
  and engineering focus of the Research Triangle Park. (Same as E50 contract terms)

Commissioner Calabria asked about the traffic impact in the surrounding area. Ms. Parker said when the site plan is ready, a traffic impact study can be completed. She said prelimary plans indicate road access off of Davis and Little Drive. She said that Little Drive is currently a two lane road and there are plans for a four lane road. She said compliance would be made with the Department of Transportation and the Town of Morrisville on the road improvements that are necessary.

Commissioner Hutchinson said that Mr. Scott Levitan, Executive Director, Research Triangle Foundation (RTF), has been instrumental in the collaboration process for the opportunity. He asked about the connection between RTF and the school staff toward the project. Ms. Parker said Mr. Levitan was instrumental in the collaboration between the RTF Owners's and Tenants Association and school staff. She said that the Town of Morrisville senior leadership was also helpful in the project. She said the space was the largest available for use in that area.

Chair Holmes said there had been concern over the Town of Morrisville being the only municipality without a high school and asked Ms. Parker to elaborate on the Town of Morrisville's request for a high school. Ms. Parker said the demand is greater than the funding stream and the ability of the market to meet it. Ms. Parker said there is collaboration with the Town of Morrisville for the project. Chair Holmes commended the schools for the partnership with Wake Tech for employment opportunities. She said land is more expensive to locate for schools.

### **Public Comments**

Miss Judith VanBoven, 3746 Horseshoe Farm St. Raleigh, NC, said that students from Middle Creek, Exploris and Knightdale High Schools have a Committee of Remembrance Project to present to the board. Students each spoke of the lynching of George Taylor 100 years ago in Wake County. They spoke of the injustice against Mr. Taylor and how they have

collected 300 containers of soil across Wake County to represent the 300 men present at his lynching. They asked the board to support a monument in Mr. Taylor's honor. The students provided soil jars for each commissioner.

Chair Holmes commended the students for coming forward and honoring history and invited them to come forward after the meeting for a photo at the board members' seats.

Ms. Jean Spooner said that she is opposed to a quarry on the RDU land near Umstead Park. She said that supports the Open Space Bonds. She said that there are no quarrys on public lands. She asked the board to protect the Oddfellows Tract.

Ms. Natalie Lew said she is opposed to a quarry next to the Oddfellows Tract. She voice her support of green space and parks. She said the land should be used as educational space for outdoor education.

Mr. Jihad Shawwa thanked Commissioner Burns and Portman for bringing the Resolution forward for the resettlement of refugees to Wake County. He shared a video about making America great.

Ms. Ana King, New Hill, NC, thanked the board for passing the Resolution for the resettlement of refugees to Wake County.

He shared her experience with housing and low income citizens. She will implement the housing plan.

Ms. McDowell said she is excited to begin work toward affordable housing. She thanked Mr. Ellis, Wake County leadership, Human Services, and the board for their support for her new position.

Chair Holmes welcomed Ms. McDowell to Wake County.

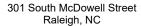

**WHEREAS**, there are numerous individuals, as well as public and private agencies that work to increase public awareness of children who are waiting to be adopted;

**WHEREAS**, we honor those families that have opened their homes and their hearts to provide a lasting loving family for children who may otherwise not have one.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Wake County Board of Commissioners, does hereby proclaim November 2018, as "Adoption Awareness Month" in Wake County.

# Resolution Reaffirming Support for the Resettlement of Refugees to Wake County

**WHEREAS**, there are more refugees in the world today than at any time since World War II, and more than half of the world's refugees are children; and

**WHEREAS**, refugees are fleeing armed conflict and human rights abuses in many areas around the world; and

**WHEREAS**, more than half of the world's refugees are hosted by only ten countries, and many of these countries do not have adequate resources to keep refugees fed, housed, or safe, leaving some refugees to survive on less than fifty cents a day; and

**WHEREAS**, refugees who need to be resettled include torture survivors, people with severe medical conditions, LGBTI individuals, children alone, and women and children at risk – all of whom can neither return home nor stay in their host country due to their extreme vulnerability; and

**WHEREAS**, the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) has determined that 1.2 million refugees are in need of immediate resettlement, but fewer than 150,000 resettlement places are available worldwide; and

**WHEREAS**, we applaud the historic, bi-partisan tradition of the United States in welcoming refugees, in keeping with our national values and respect for human rights; and

**WHEREAS**, the United Nations resettlement process does not allow refugees to choose the country to which they will be sent; and

**WHEREAS**, even if a refugee is a candidate for resettlement in the United States, he or she must still be found admissible under U.S. immigration law; and

**WHEREAS**, every single refugee must undergo a security vetting process that is lengthy, extremely detailed, and very safe, taking 18 to 24 months and involving multiple law enforcement and intelligence agencies; and

**WHEREAS**, refugees are the most vetted individuals to enter the United States and are not permitted to travel to the U.S. until all security screenings have been successfully completed; and

**WHEREAS**, Lutheran Services Carolinas and the US Committee for Refugees and Immigrants (USCRI), the organizations responsible for resettling refugees in this community, as well as numerous other community organizations and religious institutions, have declared their support for resettling refugees in Wake County; and

**WHEREAS**, Lutheran Services Carolinas and the US Committee for Refugees and Immigrants (USCRI) have resettled over 1,000 refugees in the Wake County area since 2015 from more than 17 countries; and

**WHEREAS**, Wake County has a long-standing commitment not only to being open and welcoming to refugees, but also to understanding that refugees so far resettled in our community have and will continue to make significant, positive, and lasting contributions to the life of our county.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Wake County Board of Commissioners declares its support for the resettlement of refugees no matter their religion, race, nationality, or country of origin, in Wake County and calls upon other North Carolina communities to join them in supporting a stronger national effort to resettle the most vulnerable refugees.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Wake County Board of Commissioners reaffirms that Wake County is open and welcoming to refugees.







The special tax district for the Research Triangle Park, known as the Durham-Wake Counties Research and Production Service District, was established in 1986 pursuant to G.S. 153A-310-316. The Service District is governed by an Advisory Committee which is charged with making recommendations to the respective Boards of County Commissioners for the additional tax rate to be applied to the District and with selecting the projects to be undertaken. The Advisory Committee is made up of 13 members which include: the Durham County Manager, the Wake County Manager, the President of the Research Triangle Foundation, and 10 members who are appointed by the Boards of Commissioners based on recommendations from the RTP Owners and Tenants Association. Terms are staggered so that 3 to 4 vacancies occur each year. The established procedure for appointments is that the RTP Owners and Tenants Association submits two names (a primary and a secondary) for each vacancy and both Boards of County Commissioners act on each appointment.
