
AFFIDAVIT OF JOHN BROWN

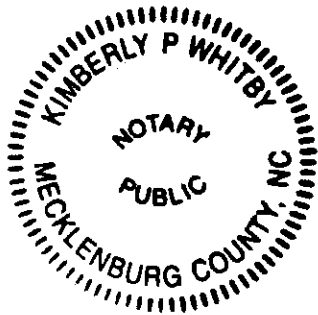

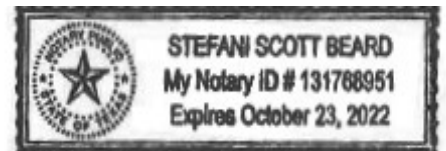


