I. Overview of Five County Stadium and the Mudcats

Mark Forestieri, Facilities Design and Construction

In 2021, Major League Baseball announced sweeping new changes to its Minor League system, including a refined classification system, and in particular, a new set of standards for minor league stadiums and facilities. This is collectively referred to as "Player Development League" or "PDL" Standards. Each Major League Team's affiliate stadiums have been evaluated and are expected to meet new standards by 2025. These standards will require significant renovations and a set of planned improvement concepts has been developed. Staff and Brewers representatives will present these concepts and recommended next steps.

The purpose of this presentation is to request that the Board authorize staff to proceed with defined next steps and to continue negotiations with the Brewers/Mudcats and Town of Zebulon to accomplish those next steps.
