






Apex HS - 35 Temporary Classrooms (TCRs)

## By 2022 enrollment is expected to increase by 20,904 students\*

- •1,119 Temporary Classrooms
- •49 ES, 17 MS, 16 HS have temporary classrooms that exceed building capacity
- •17% of ES, 12% of MS, 18% of HS seats are temporary
- •9 ES, 2 MS, 4 HS have capped enrollment
- •28 ES, 12 MS, 13 HS report significant traffic issues
- •1.3MSF 40+ years w/o major renovation
- •23.5MSF of existing schools



- Progress reducing seat shortfalls
- Can be funded within county debt plan
