

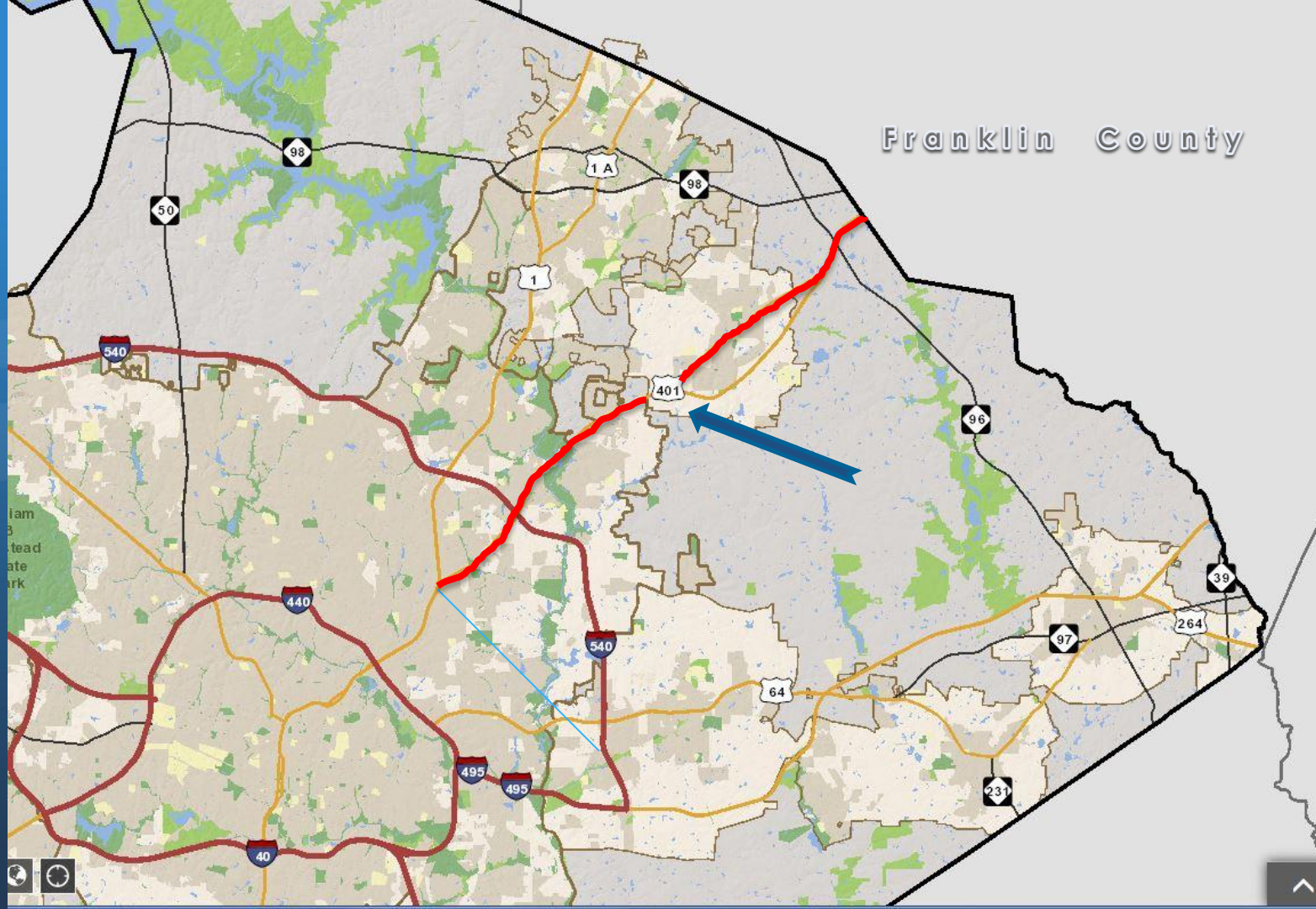

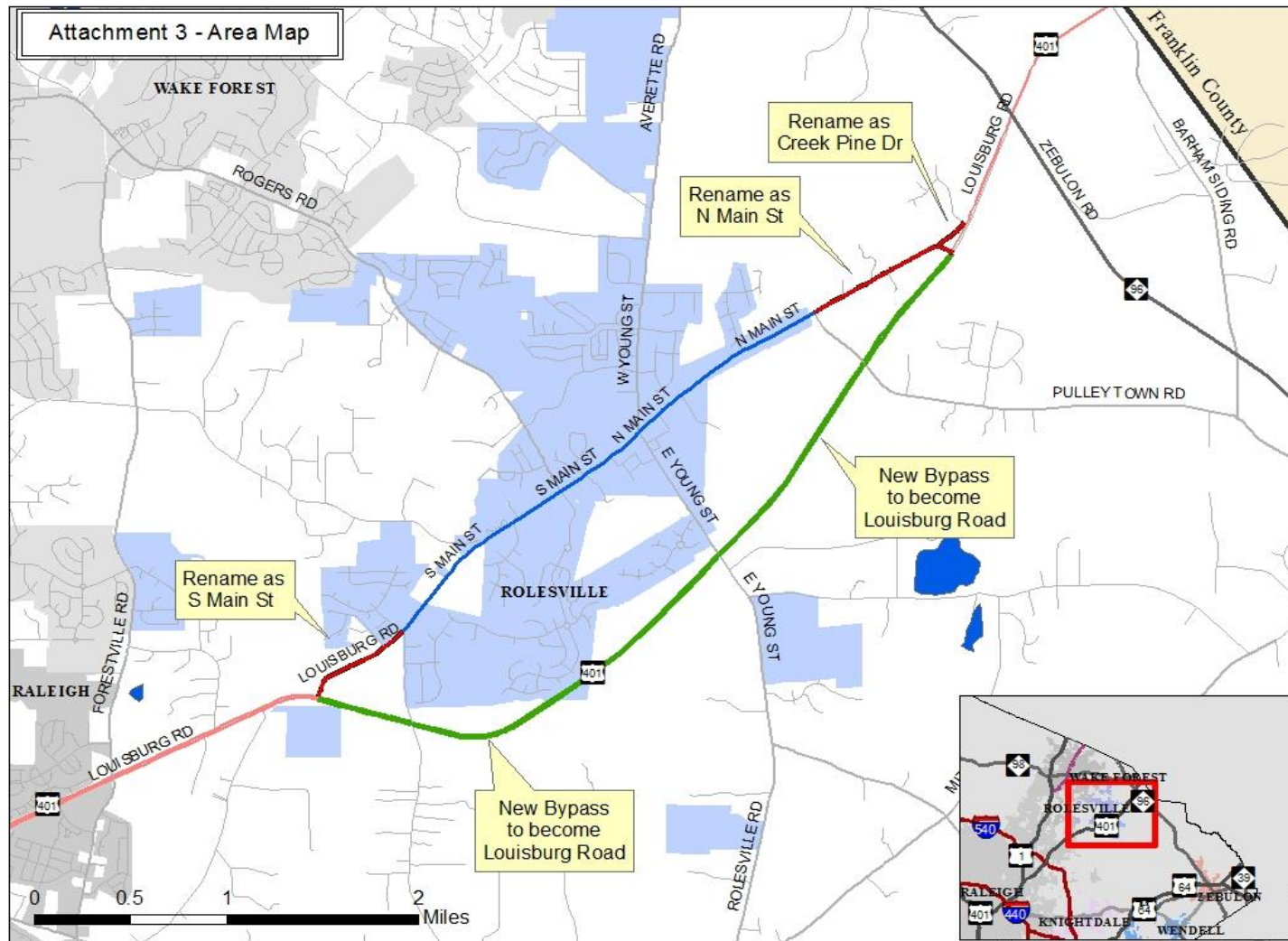
Portions of Louisburg Road to North Main Street,
South Main Street, and Creek Pine Drive



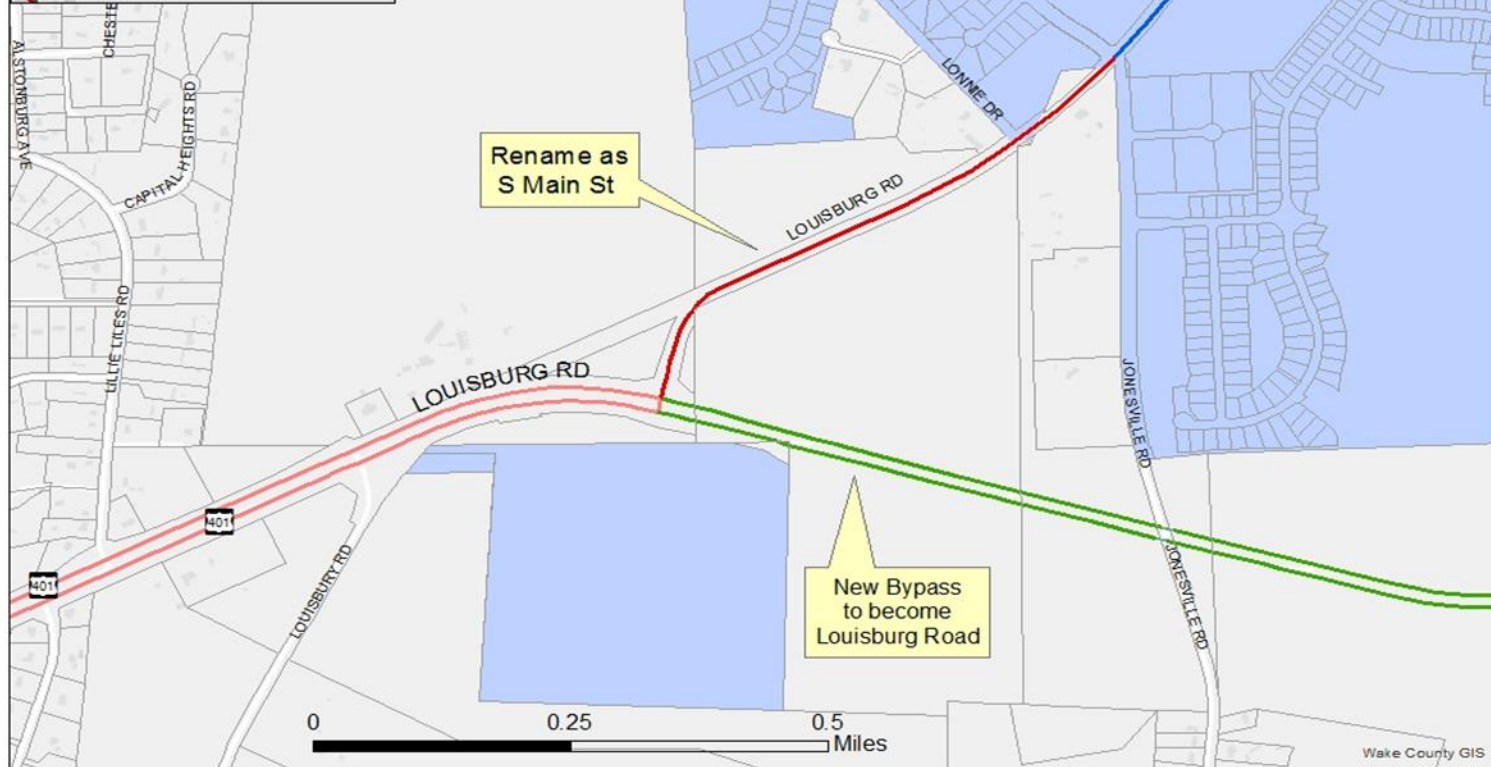
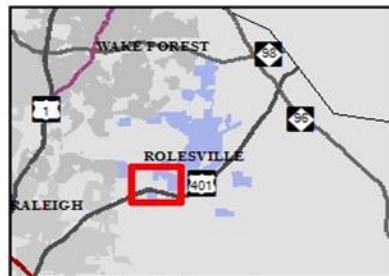

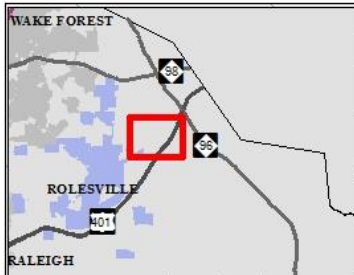


Attachment 3 - Area Map

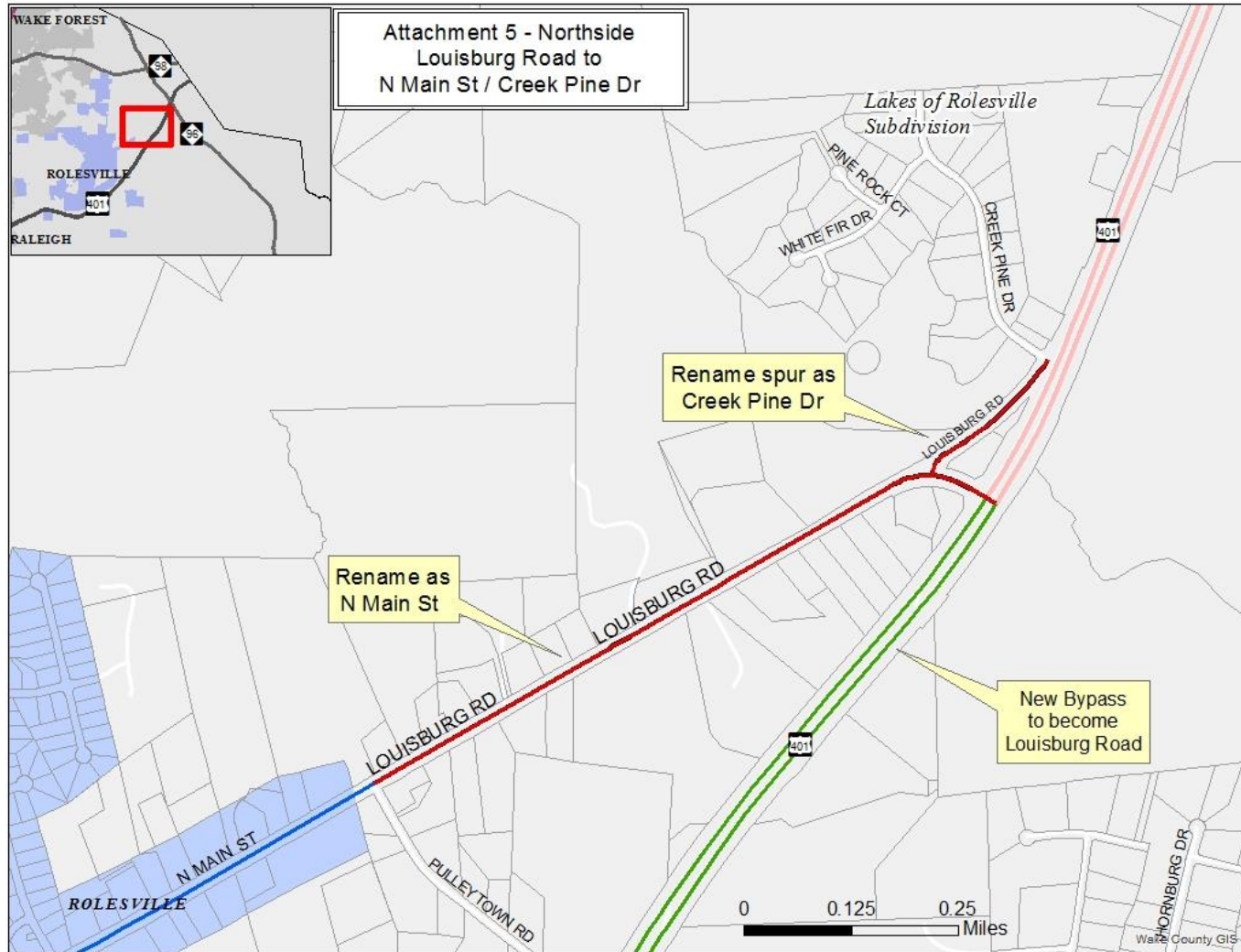


Attachment 4 - Southside

Rationale for Road Renaming

- Reduces confusion for motorists, public safety responders, and the general public
- Single name for US 401 Hwy (Louisburg Road)
- Consistent names for US 401 Bus in Rolesville (N & S Main Street)



Public Involvement

NC General Statutes

- requires that the Wake County Board of Commissioners holds a public hearing when renaming roads that are dedicated to the public and not within a city

Public Involvement

NCGS Requirements / Compliance

- Notice of Public Hearing advertised in local newspaper
- Public Hearing notices posted in (4) locations
- Public Hearing notice posted in the Wake County Courthouse

Public Involvement / Cooperation

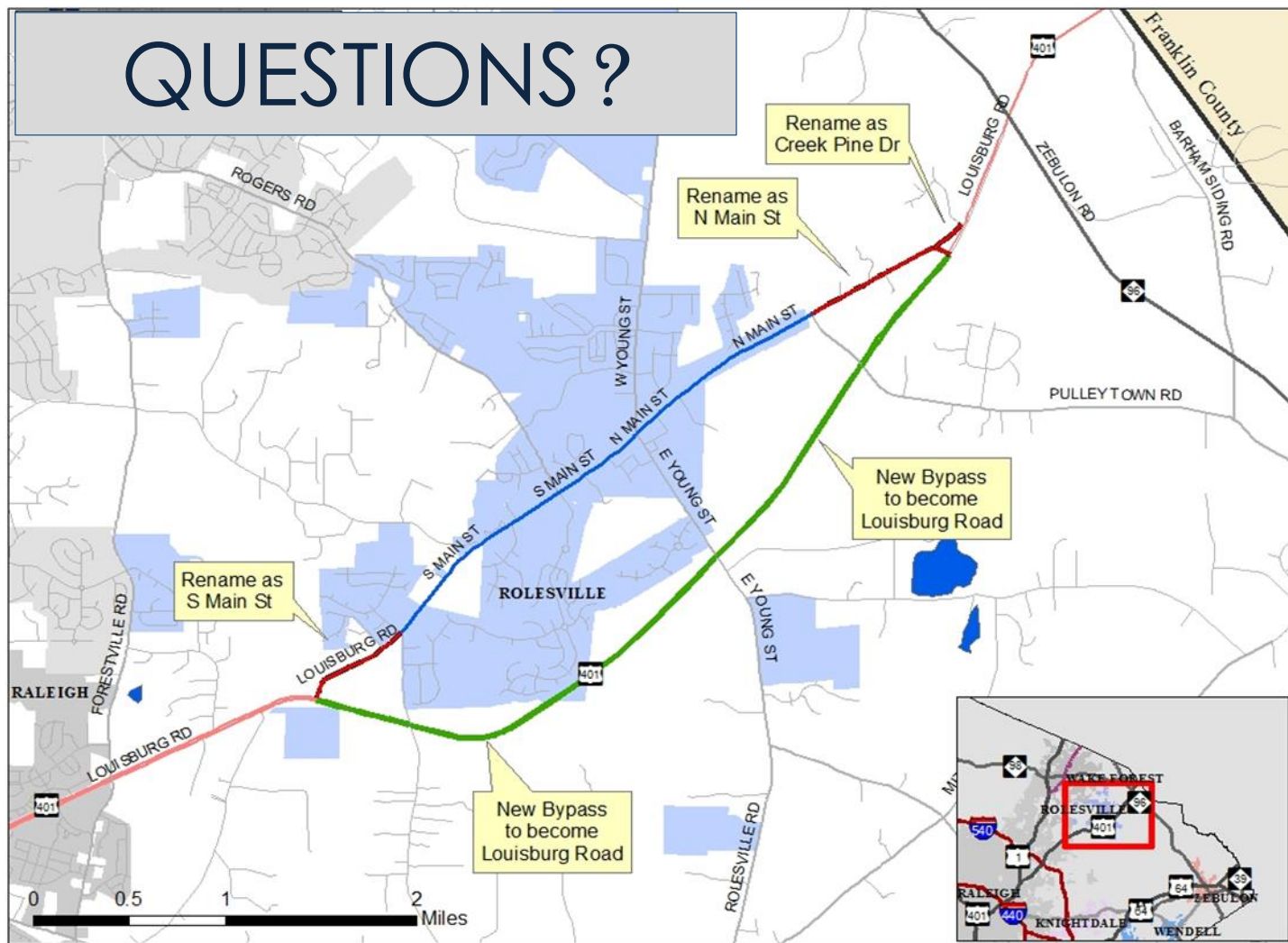
Timeline

- April 8, 2016 – Affected property owners / residents notified by mail of proposed changes with invitation to public information session
- April 19, 2016 – Joint Public Information Session
- May 2, 2016 – Town of Rolesville Resolution of Support

Impact

- (34) Address changes
- Residents may keep house numbers
- County replaces seven street signs
