Domestic Violence Fatality Review Team

Function: To identify and review domestic violence-related deaths, including homicides and suicides, and facilitate communication among the various agencies and organizations involved in domestic violence cases to prevent future fatalities.

Statute: Senate Bill 288 Section 2(a) & (b) amended SL 2009-52, as amended by SL 2013-70, to include Wake County in North Carolina counties required to establish a Domestic Violence Fatality Review Team

No. of Appointments Made By Board of Commissioners: 4 Legislation charges the Board of Commissioners to appoint up to two additional representatives from the community who have knowledge, experience or expertise in preventing domestic violence.

Length of Term (yrs.): 2 years and every three years after Appointments effective June 1 & October 14

Special Qualifications: Must agree to confidentiality

Meeting Schedule: Quarterly; Interact, Oberlin Road
