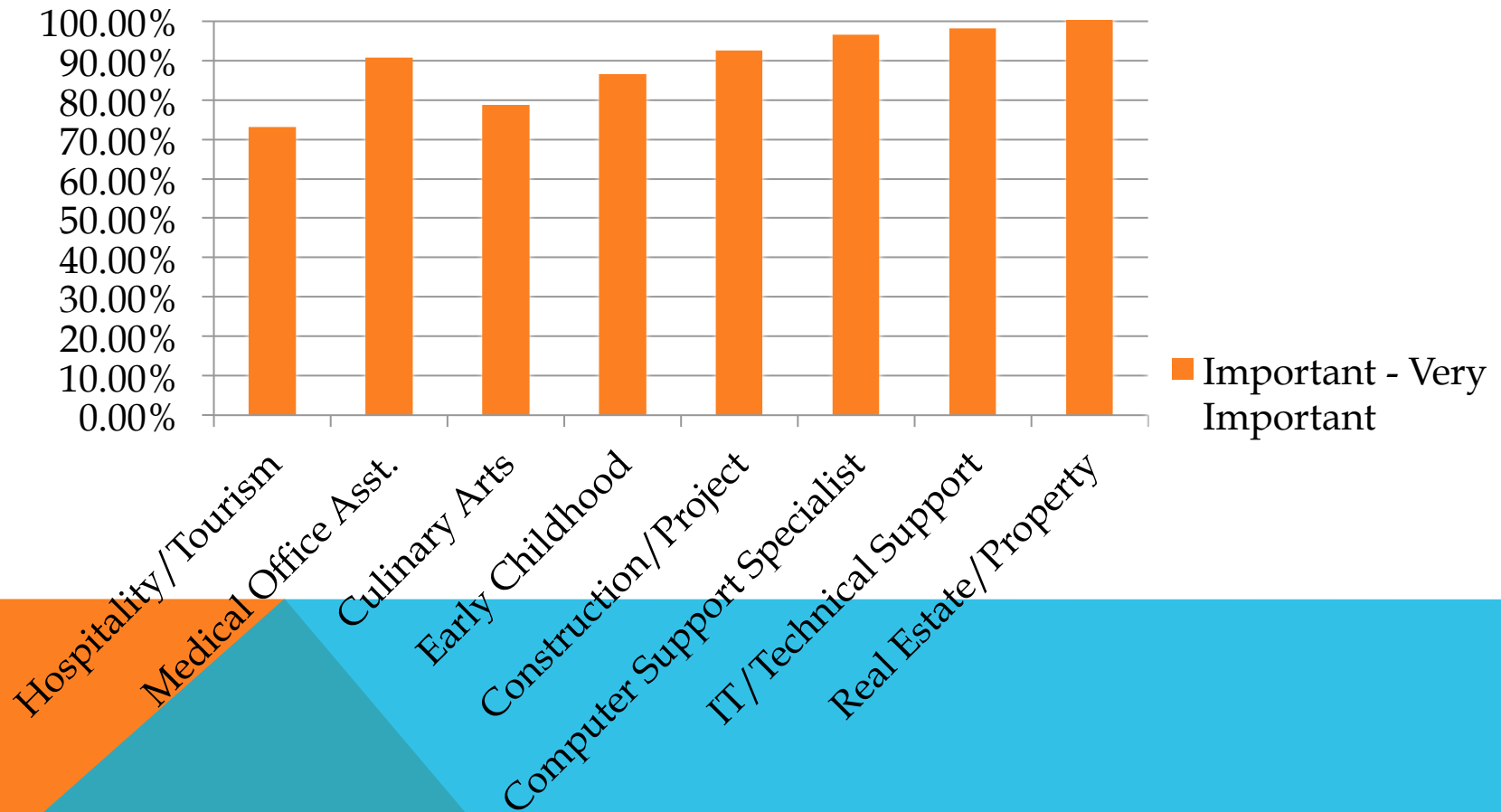

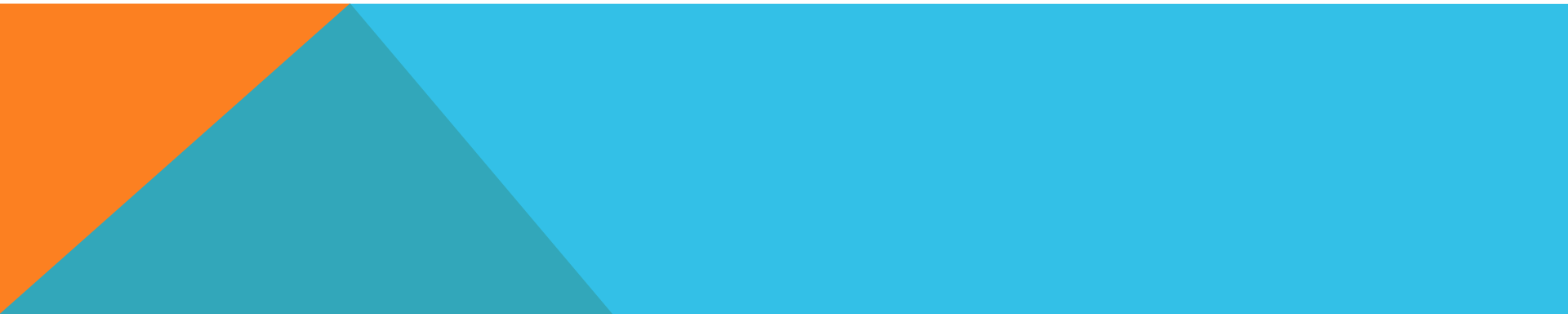

CULINARY ARTS

- The Culinary Arts program offered by WTCC prepares students for positions in a variety of food service settings, including full-service restaurants, hotels, resorts, clubs, catering operations, contract food services, and health facilities.
 - Graduates may advance to positions such as sous chef, executive chef, or food services manager.
 - 5,809 jobs are projected to be available over the next 10 years, as a result of occupational growth and replacement needs.
 - Culinary Arts certificate, diploma, and degree is available .

EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION


- WTCC's Early Childhood Education Program offers an array of focuses, including Infant/Toddler Education, Early Childhood Education, School Age Education, Family Childcare Education, and Early Childhood Administration.
- 5,662 jobs are projected to be available over the next 10 years, as a result of occupational growth and replacement needs.
- Early Childhood Education certificate, diploma and degree is available.




EMERGENCY MEDICAL SCIENCE

- WTCC's Emergency Medical Science program provides training to prepare students to become Emergency Medical Technicians and Paramedics.
- Wake County EMS Services cannot fill positions in EMS due to lack of qualified candidates.
- 450 jobs are projected to be available over the next 10 years, as a result of occupational growth and replacement needs.
- Emergency Medical Science certificate will be available and degree is available.

HOSPITALITY MANAGEMENT

- The Hospitality Management program at WTCC prepares students for professional positions in hotels, motels, resorts, inns, restaurants, clubs and other institutions.
 - Graduates of this program should qualify for supervisory or entry-level managerial positions in front office, reservations, housekeeping, purchasing, dining room and marketing.
 - 5,017 jobs are projected to be available over the next 10 years as a result of occupational growth and replacement needs.
 - Hospitality Management certificate, diploma, and degree is available.

IT – TECHNICAL SUPPORT

- WTCC's curriculum in Technical Support prepares students for employment with organizations that use computers to process, manage, and communicate information.
 - Graduates will qualify for a wide variety of computer-related, entry-level positions that provide opportunities for advancement with increasing experience and ongoing training.
 - 1,979 jobs are projected to be available over the next 10 years, as a result of occupational growth and replacement needs.
 - Hardware Support and Repair certificate and IT – Technical Support degree is available.
 - Students can also apply and test for the A+ certification and Microsoft Desktop Support Technician Industry Certification once they complete the program
