<u>Item Title:</u> Wake County Public School System CIP Reallocations and Appropriations

(First Reading)

## **Specific Action Requested:**

That the Board of Commissioners receives information from the Board of Education on requests for reallocations in CIP 2006, appropriations and reallocations in CIP 2013, and appropriations in the WCPSS Multi-Year CIP. If there are no outstanding questions, the Board of Commissioners will be asked to approve the following action items on March 6, 2017:

- 1. Reallocate a total of \$3,073,534 from CIP 2006 to CIP 2013. Decrease the CIP 2006 Plan of Record by \$3,073,534 and increase the CIP 2013 Plan of Record by \$3,073,534.
- 2. Reallocate a total of \$33,691,077 in CIP 2013 for construction at Buckhorn Creek Elementary (E-45), public infrastructure at Apex Friendship Middle and Buckhorn Creek Elementary, and startup design for the Conn Elementary and Fuguay-Varina High renovations and E-35.
- 3. Appropriate a total of \$103,501,967 in CIP 2013 for partial construction funding at one new school and two renovations, public infrastructure at two new schools, startup design for five projects, and annual requests for program management, life cycle replacements, technology, mobile classroom relocations, facility assessments, and environmental and ADA compliance
- 4. Appropriate a total of \$127,234,000 in the WCPSS multi-year CIP for partial construction at two schools, full construction at one school, partial design for two renovation projects, and public infrastructure at Vandora Springs Elementary.

#### **CIP 2006 REALLOCATIONS**

The item reallocates a total of \$3,073,534 in savings from nine projects in CIP 2006 to CIP 2013 to provide partial construction funding for the upcoming bid for Buckhorn Creek Elementary (E-45). A corresponding decrease to the CIP 2006 Plan of Record is also included in the item. This action closes out five of the nine projects, and aids in the future closing of the CIP 2006 program as a whole.

### **CIP 2013 APPROPRIATIONS AND REALLOCATIONS**

WCPSS is requesting a total appropriation of \$103,501,967. This is the last major appropriation in CIP 2013. It appropriates the remainder of construction funding for new projects included in the program, and leaves just \$6.6 million in the program to be appropriated.

#### **CIP 2013 REALLOCATIONS**

The item reallocates a total of \$33.7 million in CIP 2013: \$3.8 million of that includes achieved savings across six recently completed projects, plus anticipated savings in two other projects. The largest reallocation moves \$23.4 million from Poole Road Elementary (E-28) to Buckhorn Creek Elementary (E-45). This construction funding was initially planned for Poole Road, but that project was delayed due to traffic concerns at the site, and Buckhorn Creek was selected as its replacement. Buckhorn Creek was chosen to address significant regional crowding.

The remainder of program contingency, plus savings across five projects are also reallocated to cover public infrastructure at Apex Friendship Middle and Buckhorn Creek Elementary. A \$6.2 million reallocation will fund startup designs at three schools included in the FY2017-2023 Capital Improvement Plan.

### **Construction and Public Infrastructure**

The item appropriates the majority of construction funding for Buckhorn Creek Elementary (E-45) in Holly Springs, which is scheduled to open for student occupancy in August 2018. A \$2.4 million appropriation will fund public infrastructure at Buckhorn Creek and Apex Friendship Middle. The CIP 2013 appropriation in this item includes \$2.9 million and \$2.0 million, respectively, for the Apex High and Vandora Springs renovations. An additional \$45.8 million appropriation for Apex High is also included in this item as part of the FY2017 appropriation. The remainder of construction funding for

Vandora Springs, totaling \$33.7 million, is also included as part of the FY2017 appropriation.

## **Startup Designs**

This request includes \$6.5 million for startup design at E-35 and renovations at Conn Elementary and Fuquay-Varina High. Construction at Fuquay-Varina is scheduled to begin in the summer of 2019, with the school re-opening for student occupancy in August 2021. Construction at Conn is scheduled to begin in 2019 and re-open for students in August 2020. E-35 construction is scheduled to begin in 2019. The item also includes \$250,000 in preliminary design funding to determine scope for two future renovation projects in the seven year plan.

### **Life Cycle Replacements**

The item includes the fourth and final appropriation for life-cycle replacement at schools throughout the County. The list of planned projects is included as an attachment to this item.

## Furniture and Educational Equipment Replacements, Environmental and ADA

WCPSS will also replace equipment and furniture throughout the system and perform improvements to meet environmental and ADA compliance. The furniture and equipment replacement process involves working with each school to determine needs they may have to replace items that are a health/safety issue, broken, obsolete or which no longer serve the original purpose for which they were provided. These needs are then prioritized by health and safety issues first, and then type of need, age of school or time since last renovation. This is the third and final request in CIP 2013.

# **Technology**

This item appropriates \$15.0 million for technology infrastructure and draws down all of the remaining funding for technology in the program. This will be used for the modernization of network equipment, cabling and power in addition to expanding wireless coverage in the schools. These funds will improve the reliability and functionality of internet and intranet connections in instructional spaces.

### **Mobile Classroom Relocations**

The item appropriates the remainder of funds for mobile classroom relocations in CIP 2013, bringing the total appropriation to \$7.6 million. The original Plan of Record included \$17.6 million for mobile relocations, but \$10 million was reallocated to other projects as WCPSS has received fewer requests for mobile relocations than originally anticipated at the outset of CIP 2013. This is due to lower than anticipated enrollment growth, enrollment caps at some schools, and limited space for modular classrooms on some campuses.

#### **Fiscal Year 2017 Appropriations**

The item also includes the first appropriation request for the new WCPSS Multi-Year Capital Improvement Plan, and appropriates \$127,234,000 for five projects included in the plan. This covers partial construction funding for Willow Spring High (H-13) and the Apex High renovation, plus the remainder of construction funding for the Vandora Springs Elementary renovation, which was partially funded in CIP 2013. It also includes \$3.2 million in partial design funding for renovations at East Wake Middle and Fuquay-

Varina High. A \$550,000 appropriation will fund public infrastructure at the Vandora Springs renovation.

#### **Staff Comments**

This appropriation is in accordance with the funding schedules for CIP 2013 and the WCPSS Multi-Year Capital Improvement Plan. County staff will continue to work with WCPSS to close out the CIP 2006 program, finalize CIP 2013 appropriations, and update the Multi-Year CIP.
