WHEREAS, the Stony Hill Fire Department is consolidating into the Bay Leaf Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, this consolidation will increase the efficiency of fire protection services in northern Wake County; and

WHEREAS, the boundaries of the Bay Leaf Fire Insurance District will be modified to include the area currently in the Stony Hill Fire Insurance District; and

WHEREAS, the Bay Leaf Fire Department, DBA Northern Wake Fire Department provides fire protection and related emergency services in the Bay Leaf Fire Insurance District; and

WHEREAS, the Bay Leaf Fire Insurance District will be renamed the Northern Wake Fire Insurance District:

That, pursuant to the authority granted by N.C.G.S. Section 153A-233, the Wake County Board of Commissioners hereby officially approves the abolishment of the Stony Hill Fire Insurance District as identified and mapped in the Wake County Geographical Information System (GIS) database.
