Bill Greeves Named C-Suite Award Winner

In August, Chief Information and Innovation Officer Bill Greeves was named a C-Suite Award winner by Triangle Business Journal. These awards honor outstanding C-level executives in a variety of industries for their contributions to the Triangle community.

Public Libraries’ Reading Program Video Recognized for Excellence

Wake County Public Libraries received a public relations award for their animated video *Summer Reading 2016: Get in the Game...Read*. The annual PR Xchange Awards, sponsored by the American Library Association’s Library Leadership Administration and Management’s Public Relations and Marketing Section, recognize the very best public relations materials produced by libraries in the past year.

Wake County’s video was among 390 entries submitted. Entries were evaluated on content, originality and design by a team of experts in public relations, graphic design, communications and marketing.

Human Services Receives Certificate for Child Support

Wake County Human Services was awarded the Certificate for Child Support by the North Carolina Child Support Council. Only five other counties in the state received this award, which was presented by NC Child Support Chief Judy McArn during a recent conference.

Wake County earned the award for meeting performance measures including:

- Percent of current support collected;
- Percent of cases with Paternity/Support Orders established, and
- Percent of collections to liquidate past due child support.

In addition, Wake County’s Child Support team collected \$48,709,472 in child support and established paternity and cash/medical support obligations for more than 2,350 cases.
