I held that position until January 2014 in which sales grew to \$21.5M with a workforce of 18-26 people. In January 2014 I assumed the role of Carolina Division Manager in which I inherited a division of 150 employees and 17 locations in two states with annual revenue of \$84M. Four years later the division now has 285 employees and \$196M in revenue that spans 25 locations in 4 states. My job responsibilities include many facets of business that entail each of the following disciplines: strategic planning, annual forecasting, discovering and executing start-up and acquisition opportunities, recruiting and development of future managers, legal and ethical matters, P&L management, supplier agreements and initiatives, manager placements, interfacing with key customers, involvement with difficult credit and collection matters, lease negotiations for office and warehouse space, and many other matters that apply to doing business in today's marketplace.
