

**Resolution R-2018-  
Reallocate and Appropriate Funds in WCPSS Capital Programs**

**WHEREAS**, the Wake County Board of Education is engaged in Long Range Building Programs; and

**WHEREAS**, the Wake County Board of Education has duly requested that the Board of Commissioners appropriate \$54,021,982 in the Seven Year Capital Improvement Program for construction funding at Barton Pond Elementary (E-24), partial construction funding for renovations at Wiley And North Ridge Elementary Schools and preliminary design funding for York and Fuller Elementary schools; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Wake County Board of Commissioners hereby reallocates and appropriates funds as follows:
