

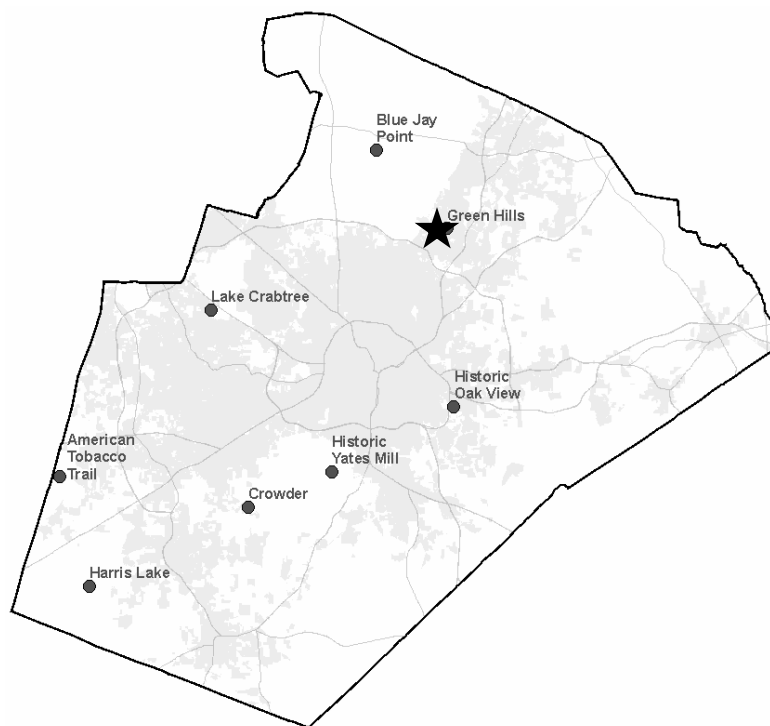
Item Title: Rename North Wake Landfill District Park

Specific Action Requested:

That the Board of Commissioners renames North Wake Landfill District Park as Green Hills County Park.

Item Summary:

Wake County Parks, Recreation, and Open Space (PROS) provides outdoor recreation and educational opportunities while promoting environmental and cultural stewardship through a managed system of parks and open spaces. Following a process outlined to the Board of Commissioners, and based on stakeholder feedback, PROS requests a name change for North Wake Landfill District Park to Green Hills County Park.



The suggested name was arrived at through a public input and committee process. PROS solicited name suggestions from staff, county stakeholders, and park users during the month of October and early November in the nearby parks and online. In late November, staff presented the gathered suggestions to a naming committee that included members from PROS, OSAPAC, Communications, GSA, and Solid Waste. This committee reviewed the collected suggestions to arrive at this recommendation.

Name suggestions were solicited through the following channels:

- Article in October edition of Insights to let staff know that they could submit ideas.
- Posts on the North Wake Landfill District Park webpage and Facebook page throughout the month including a form for visitors to submit their suggestions.
- Shared information on the @wakegovparks Twitter and Instagram accounts.
- Placed signage and suggestion cards at the park for visitors to submit suggestions.

Naming or renaming buildings owned by Wake County requires Board of Commissioners approval. This name change is consistent with the board's "Policy for Naming Property Belonging to the County of Wake" (Attachment A).

Cost of sign changes will be funded through the PROS operating budget. The Open Space and Parks Advisory Committee last reviewed the name change at its March 2018 meeting and recommended the name change be forwarded to the Board of Commissioners for its consideration.
