I. November 2018 Referendum Update – Emily Lucas

To place a general obligation bond referendum questions on the ballot in November 2018, the Board must take formal actions beginning in June. At the May 14 work session, staff reviewed scenarios and financial planning for a proposed schools construction bond in November 2018. Staff will share information to respond to Commissioner questions raised at the prior work session. Staff will also review the debt model and tax rate implications of the bond program requested by the Board of Education. The Board will be asked to provide staff direction or identify any additional information needed prior to deciding on the bond questions.
