## Resolution R-2018-Reallocate and Appropriate Funds in WCPSS Capital Programs

**WHEREAS,** the Wake County Board of Education is engaged in Long Range Building Programs; and

WHEREAS, on February 19, 2018 the Board of Commissioners approved accelerated funding for partial construction of Parkside Elementary to be temporarily funded with CIP 2013 Life Cycle Replacement Funds; and

WHEREAS, on April 2, 2018, the Board of Commissioners approved accelerated funding for partial construction of North Ridge Elementary to be temporarily funded with Debt Service Fund fund balance; and
