### **Open Space Preservation Program**

Purpose – to protect and conserve County land and water for current residents and future generations.

Land that would...

- Preserve natural resources, wildlife habitat, and historical and cultural properties;
- Protect forest and farm land, scenic landscapes, riparian corridors and water quality;
- Provide venues for outdoor recreation.



## **Open Space Preservation Program**

Protected outright or through partnership:

- 6,500 acres;
- Partnerships have included ten local municipalities, non-profits, the State of North Carolina, and the federal government


Assisted with design and construction:

- 21.8 miles of greenway trail;
- Partnerships have included seven local municipalities



### Watson Open Space Acquisition

- Approximately 37 acres;
- Marks Creek area;
- Adjacent to and upstream from the Turnipseed Nature Preserve;
- Estimated total acquisition cost is \$760,000





### **Specific Action Requested**

#### That the Board of Commissioners:

- Appropriates \$760,000 of Open Space funding; and
- Authorizes the County Manager to execute an agreement to purchase specific acreage from the following: Watson Family Farms of Marks Creek, LLC; Ada Watson Sorrell; Watson and Watson of NC, Limited Partnership; and Olen L. Watson, subject to terms and conditions acceptable to the County Attorney.
