

RESOLUTION 2018-130-0 OF THE MORRISVILLE TOWN COUNCIL PERTAINING TO REQUESTING EXTENSION OF THE TOWN'S EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION

WHEREAS, the North Carolina General Assembly has provided in Chapter 160A-360 of the North Carolina General Statutes a process for municipalities with populations of between 10,000 and 25,000 to extend their jurisdiction for up to two (2) miles beyond their corporate limits with approval by the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the area requested for extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ) extension is designated by the Wake County Land Use Plan as lying in the Town of Morrisville's short-range urban service area; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Morrisville has demonstrated a commitment to comprehensive planning through its past planning efforts and present process to update the Morrisville Land Use Plan and Morrisville Transportation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Morrisville, through the Town of Cary Utilities Department, is developing plans to serve this area with public water and sewer; and

WHEREAS, future development within this area will be at urban and suburban densities and voluntarily annexed into the Town of Morrisville's corporate limits; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Morrisville has continued to make steady progress over the last five years in annexing and supplying municipal services throughout its existing ETJ; and

WHEREAS, the area designated for ETJ extension is within two (2) miles of Morrisville's corporate limits; and

WHEREAS, the Town's official certified population estimate from the 2015 Special Census of Morrisville stands at 23,699 for April 9, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Morrisville anticipates holding a public hearing on the question of adopting an ordinance extending its ETJ and the setting of zoning districts in the area upon County approval of this request:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE MORRISVILLE TOWN COUNCIL requests that Wake County designate as Morrisville ETJ the area shown in the attached "Town of Morrisville ETJ Extension Request Report" and more specifically, parcel PIN 0746181372 and 0736616463.
