- Standardized Fare Structure Amongst GoRaleigh, GoCary, GoTriangle, GoDurham
 - o Offer same discount strategy for Under 18, 65+, Disabilities
- Investigation of Peers for Low Income Approach (San Francisco Lifeline, ORCA Lift Seattle/Pugent Sound, PSTA (St Petersburg FL/Clearwater FL)
 - o 100% FPL, 150% FPL, 200% FPL, Other Determinants
- Investigation of Fare Capping with Smart Fare Card Technology
 Once number of day trips taken reach the cost of a monthly pass, remaining trips are free
- Expansion of GoPass Programs (# Employees, By Neighborhood, Service Area)
- New Pass Sales Partnerships





- Draft Strategy Amongst Transit Providers
- Discuss Fare Strategy with Transit Agency Governing Boards
- Prepare Implementation Schedule for Changes
- Prepare for Technology Upgrades in Scalable Fashion and Complete Regional Integration Technology Study
