<u>Item Title:</u> Resolution to Modify the Alert Fire Insurance District Map Boundaries

Specific Action Requested:

That the Board of Commissioners adopts a resolution modifying the Alert Fire Insurance District.

Item Summary:

Purpose: North Carolina General Statute 153A – 233 authorizes the Board of

County Commissioners to designate fire districts and approve the

district boundaries thereof for insurance grading purposes.

Background: In February 2018, the Wake County Board of Commissioners

adopted by resolution a map of the Alert Fire Insurance District that omitted an area on Battle Bridge Road owned by the City of Raleigh. This property was mistakenly omitted due to an oversight while using response areas and insurance boundaries. The omitted area is comprised of parcels totaling approximately 1,462 acres and is located at 8500 Battle Bridge Road. This property is owned by the City of Raleigh and is the site of the city's waste water treatment facility. The new map has been approved by the Department of


Insurance and is accurate.
