Purpose – to protect and conserve County land and water for current residents and future generations

Land that would...

- Preserve natural resources, wildlife habitat, and historical and cultural properties;
- Protect forest and farm land, scenic landscapes, riparian corridors and water quality;
- Provide venues for outdoor recreation.



Open Space Preservation Program

Protected outright or through partnership:

- 7,634 acres
- Partnerships have included ten local municipalities, non-profits, the State of North Carolina, and the federal government

Assisted with design and construction:

- 23.3 miles of greenway trail
- Partnerships have included eight local municipalities






- Connecting the South Lakes neighborhood to the Town's Honeycutt Park
- Estimated protect cost is \$1,150,000; County's participation is \$257,432 or 22%


