

**Item Title:** Resolution Honoring the American Legion's 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary

**Specific Action Requested:**

**That the Board of Commissioners approves the resolution honoring the American Legion on their 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary.**

**Item Summary:**

The American Legion was chartered by Congress in 1919 as a patriotic veteran's organization focusing on service to veterans, service members and communities. The Legion evolved from a group of veterans of World War I into one of the most influential nonprofit groups in the United States. Membership swiftly grew to over 1 million, and local posts sprang up across the country.

Today, membership stands at over 2 million in more than 13,000 posts worldwide.
