A PROFILE OF HORACE SMITH

Horace Smith is the son of the late Archie and Hattie Smith; the grandson of the late Jack and Cornelia Smith; and the great-grandson of the late Archie and Rachal Smith. Horace was born on a farm near Clarkton, North Carolina and graduated from Booker T. Washington High School in Clarkton. He currently resides in Raleigh, North Carolina. In 1964, he graduated from Virginia State University in Petersburg, Virginia with a Bachelor of Science degree in Agronomy (Soil Science). He began his career as a soil scientist with the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Soil Conservation Service (SCS) in June 1964 in Champaign, Illinois. In later years, the agency changed its name to USDA Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS). In 1972, Horace was awarded the Master of Science degree in Soil Genesis and Classification from The Ohio State University in Columbus, Ohio. He has done further graduate studies at the University of Illinois, Champaign-Urbana, Illinois; Michigan State University, East Lansing, Michigan; and Texas A&M University, College Station, Texas. In 1997, Horace graduated from the Federal Executive Institute in Charlottesville, Virginia and was inducted into the Federal Senior Executive Service that same year.

Horace has worked with the SCS/NRCS in progressively more responsible positions in Illinois, Ohio, Maryland, Pennsylvania, North Carolina, Georgia, and Washington, D.C. In 1974, he was selected to the position of Project Leader for the District of Columbia Soil Survey, the first all-urban soil survey ever conducted in the United States. This project represented USDA's contribution to the United States Bicentennial, which culminated in 1976. Other key positions he has held include: Assistant Principal Soil Correlator at the Northeast National Technical Center, Broomall, Pennsylvania; State Soil Scientist, Raleigh, North Carolina; and Regional Soil Scientist, Atlanta, Georgia. Horace has received numerous awards during his career, including the prestigious George Washington Carver Public Service Hall of Fame Award and the North Carolina Soil Science Society Annual Achievement Award. He was recently recognized on the **Wall of Fame** at the National Soil Survey Center in Lincoln, Nebraska for "Excellence in the Field of Soil Survey Leadership."

He has represented his agency on short-term international assignments to Canada, Mexico, West Africa, Taiwan, Brazil, Italy, Spain, and Denmark. He has written several technical reports and scientific articles on anthropogenic soils, production soil survey, and related topics. Horace's most recent position was Director of the Soil Survey Division, NRCS, Washington, D.C. He held that position from November 1996 until his retirement. In that position, Horace provided leadership for the federal part of the National Cooperative Soil Survey, and in planning, directing, and coordinating the agency's comprehensive Soil Survey Program. His duties also included overall leadership and guidance for the National Soil Survey Center in Lincoln, Nebraska and the Soil Quality Institute at Iowa State University in Ames, Iowa. He was a major contributor to the exhibit at the Smithsonian National Museum of Natural History in Washington, D.C. entitled "Dig It! The Secrets of Soil."

Horace is a member of the American Society of Agronomy, Soil Science Society of America, International Union of Soil Sciences, and the Soil Science Society of North Carolina. He is a registered soil scientist with the American Registry of Certified

Professionals in Agronomy, Crops and Soils, and the North Carolina Registry of Certified Professionals in Soils.

Horace is married to the former Myra Dawn Parrish of Madison Heights, Virginia and they are the proud parents of three grown children--Cherie, Christopher, and Stacy; and grandparents of Sarah. His hobbies include reading, photography, gardening/landscaping, travel, golf, and volunteering.

After 38 years of public service, Horace retired from the NRCS on January 3, 2002. He currently is a part-time consultant in soil and natural resources and serves on the Wake County Sustainability Task Force. He is also Chairman of the Board of Deacons at Martin Street Baptist Church in Raleigh, North Carolina and a member of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc.
