<u>Item Title:</u> Public Hearing to Consider Renaming Portion of Carpenter Fire

Station Road

Specific Action Requested:

That the Board of Commissioners holds a public hearing and adopts the attached ordinance to rename permanently a 0.1 mile portion of Carpenter Fire Station Road as Bandelier Lane, effective August 1, 2019.

Item Summary:

Purpose: State statute requires the Board of Commissioners to hold a public

hearing to rename state owned streets outside the corporate limits

of municipalities.

Background: On March 28, 2019, the Town of Cary passed a Resolution to change

the name of the street segment that is affected by the closure of a CSX railroad crossing as part of a project to realign Morrisville Carpenter Road. This project splits Carpenter Fire Station Road and changes the traffic flow. A portion of this road is in the extraterritorial jurisdiction and requires the county to hold a public hearing before the Board of Commissioners. North Carolina General Statute §


