<u>Item Title:</u> Interlocal Agreement Between the Town of Zebulon and Wake

County Regarding Administration of Zebulon's Stormwater

Ordinance and Erosion and Sedimentation Control Ordinance

Specific Action Requested:

That the Board of Commissioners authorizes the County Manager to execute an Interlocal Agreement between the Town of Zebulon and Wake County regarding the County's continued administration of Zebulon's Stormwater Ordinance and Erosion and Sedimentation Control Ordinance.

Item Summary:

Purpose: The Board of Commissioners approves interlocal agreements for the

provision of services by Wake County.

Background: Wake County has administered Zebulon's Erosion and

Sedimentation Control Ordinance for decades and its Stormwater Ordinance for 10 years. Services provided under this agreement include development construction plan review, permitting of land disturbances, inspection of construction sites over the life of the project, technical assistance to permittees and code enforcement to ensure regulatory compliance. The current Interlocal Agreement ends on June 30, 2019. The attached Interlocal Agreement provides for the continuation of services by Wake County from the date of

execution through June 30, 2029.

Board Goal: This action supports routine County operations.

Fiscal Impact: There is no fiscal impact from this action. Under the agreement,

Wake County collects fees from developers applying for erosion and sedimentation control and stormwater approval in accordance with the fee schedule approved by the Board of Commissioners. The fees are retained by Wake County to pay for the cost of personnel, equipment, space and resources needed to administer the

ordinance.

Additional Information:

The Town of Zebulon's governing board approved this Interlocal Agreement at their May 6, 2019 meeting. Zebulon's Mayor has executed three originals.
