## ORDINANCE APPROVING THE REQUEST TO RENAME A PORTION OF CARPENTER FIRE STATION ROAD

## AN ORDINANCE TO RENAME A PORTION OF CARPENTER FIRE STATION ROAD (SR 1624) WITHIN THE TOWN OF CARY EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION

**WHEREAS,** Carpenter Fire Station Road (SR 1624) is being realigned pursuant to the Town of Cary's Carpenter Fire Station Road Realignment Project ("Project"); and

**WHEREAS,** as part of Project, the at-grade railroad crossing located on Carpenter Fire Station Road and to the east of NC 55 was closed, which caused Carpenter Fire Station Road to no longer be a continuous road; and

**WHEREAS,** the closure resulted in a 0.1-mile remnant of Carpenter Fire Station Road ("Remnant") located east of the closed railroad crossing being isolated from the remainder of Carpenter Fire Station Road to the west; and

**WHEREAS**, to enhance public safety response, the Remnant needs to be named; and

**WHEREAS,** the Remnant lies within the unincorporated limits of Wake County, so Wake County is the entity with the authority to rename the Remnant; and

**WHEREAS**, the Remnant is also within the Town of Cary's extra-territorial jurisdiction, Wake County has asked the Town of Cary to recommend a new name for the Remnant; and

**WHEREAS**, after having given full and complete consideration to the matter, it now appears to the satisfaction of the Town Council of the Town of Cary that Wake County should rename the Remnant to Bandelier Lane due to it having the support of affected property owners and furthering the purposes of public safety; and

WHEREAS, North Carolina General Statute § 153A-239.1(a) authorizes a county to rename any road within the county and not within a city by means of an advertised public hearing before the board of commissioners, whereupon the local postmaster, Board of Transportation, and any city within five miles of the road is notified of the approval; and

**WHEREAS,** the Town of Cary Planning Department, Wake County Addressing/E911 Team, approved the availability, appropriateness, and use of the name Bandelier Lane on March 29, 2017 for the segment of SR 1624 extending from the intersection with Morrisville Carpenter Road west to the CSX Railroad right of way; and

**WHEREAS**, the Cary Town Council passed a resolution supporting the name changes at their March 28, 2019 meeting; and

**WHEREAS**, the General Statutes of the State of North Carolina (G.S. 153A-239.1) delegates authority to name and rename roads to the Wake County Board of Commissioners and prescribe procedures to be followed in the process; and

**WHEREAS**, this request was duly advertised and was the subject of a public hearing by the Wake County Board of Commissioners on May 20, 2019 and was duly considered; and

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE WAKE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WAKE, NORTH CAROLINA, AS FOLLOWS:

That the portion of SR 1624 located within Town of Cary extraterritorial jurisdiction between Morrisville Carpenter Road and the CSX Railroad right of way. Effective August 1, 2019.
