New Project: 2019 PSH RFP

Wake County Received two projects that passed the minimum scoring criteria for further consideration.

Lead Applicants for consideration:

- CASA Developers
- Centre for Homeownership with Haven Developers

Projects were scored based on the following criteria:

- Organizational Expertise
- Supportive Services
- Location Information
- o Project Information
- Financial Analysis
- Community Considerations

Minimum core for consideration = 60 Points

Project Scoring Comparison

CASA: King's Ridge

King's Ridge would include 60 one and two bedroom apartments, 30 of which would be PSH and 30 would be for workforce housing, targeting households earning less than 60% of AMI.

The project would include space for:

- CASA leasing and Maintenance staff to work on-site
- Supportive Service Provider group and one-on-one meetings
- Multi-use community room
- Laundry center
- Playground
- Outdoor gathering areas

Project Scoring Comparison

Centre for Homeownership with Haven Developers: Rock Quarry Road Permanent Supportive Housing

There are two potential locations for this project.

Unit count rages from 88-128, with a mix of PSH, Affordable Housing, Market rate Housing and (potentially) commercial.

The project would include space for:

- Computer room
- Lounge
- Supportive Service Provider and one-on-one meetings
- In unit washer/dryer

- Small fitness room
- Shared community gardens
- group• Shared patio
 - "Family" lawn
 - Tenant patios/decks
