


Sharing PROS Background

 - o 2600+ programs





Set priorities and implement strategies for the use of new bond funds for parks, open space and greenways."



- BOC Vote at 1/7/19 Meeting
 - "Establish that the development of the Southeast County Park shall be the first priority of the 2018 Parks, Greenways, Recreation and Open Space Bond."


Creating the Mission Statement

- Promote Human Health and Wellness








OUTLINE OF HISTORIC ROADS AND BUILDINGS
